AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING THE OFFER FROM SIDDONS-MARTIN EMERGENCY GROUP, LLC TO PROVIDE THE SAN ANTONIO FIRE DEPARTMENT WITH TWO ADDITIONAL DODGE 5500 TYPE 6 BRUSH TRUCKS FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$355,994.00, FUNDED FROM THE FY2016 ADOPTED CAPITAL BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by Siddons-Martin Emergency Group, LLC to provide the City of San Antonio Fire Department with two Brush Trucks for a total cost of \$355,994.00; and

WHEREAS, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the Houston/Galveston Area Council of Governments Cooperative Purchasing Agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio on October 10, 1996 through Resolution No. 96-41-48, **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The offer from Siddons-Martin Emergency Group, LLC to provide the City of San Antonio Fire Department with two Brush Trucks for a cost of \$355,994.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the bid tabulation sheet and contract are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Payment in the amount of the \$355,994.00 in SAP Fund 40099000, Other Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 20-00045, City South Annexation - Fire Equipment, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to Siddons-Martin Emergency Group, LLC, for two Dodge 5500 Type 6 Brush Trucks.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
