AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$1,500,000.00 TO THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE AGENCY FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE 2016 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM TO PREVENT, RESPOND TO, AND RECOVER FROM ACTS OF TERRORISM AND NATURAL DISASTERS; AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE FUNDS, UPON AWARD.

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WHEREAS, the State Administrative Agency (SAA) has grant funds of as much as \$1,500,000.00 available from the 2016 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the 2016 HSGP is to enhance the ability of governments to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism and natural disasters; and

WHEREAS, the grant application includes a request for funding of five personnel positions and partial funding for one additional personnel position; and

WHEREAS, no matching contribution is required; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to submit a grant application in an amount not to exceed to \$1,500,000.00 to the 2016 HSGP for grant funds from the SAA to assist the City in preventing, responding to, and recovering from acts of terrorism and natural disasters. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to accept said grant, if awarded under substantially the same terms and conditions as applied for. The City Manager and her designee are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said application and acceptance.

SECTION 2. Upon approval of this Ordinance, a new fund and internal order number will be created. The personnel complement of five employees set out in **Exhibit I** is hereby approved.

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SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts, as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
