## AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING CONTRACTS WITH GOODWILL INDUSTRIES OF SAN ANTONIO AND DUE AMICIS, INC. D/B/A GREEN LANDSCAPING TO PROVIDE LANDSCAPING SERVICES AND IRRIGATION MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR SERVICES FOR THE BUILDING AND EQUIPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT FOR AN ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$198,000.00 ANNUALLY, FUNDED FROM THE FY2016 OPERATING FUND.

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**WHEREAS**, the City released Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals (RFCSP) to provide the City with landscaping services and irrigation maintenance and repair services for the Building and Equipment Services Department; and

WHEREAS, five responses were received and evaluated; and

**WHEREAS**, staff recommends Goodwill Industries of San Antonio for zone 1 (landscaping locations without irrigation) and Due Amicis, Inc. d/b/a Green Landscaping for zone 2 (landscaping locations with irrigation) for award of this contract; **NOW THEREFORE:** 

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The proposals submitted by Goodwill Industries of San Antonio for zone 1 and Due Amicis, Inc. d/b/a Green Landscaping for zone 2 to provide the City with landscaping services and irrigation maintenance and repair services for the Building and Equipment Services Department are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the score summary, RFCSP, and price schedule are attached hereto as **Exhibit I**. A copy of the proposal may be inspected in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.

**SECTION 2.** The amounts will be encumbered upon issuance of a purchase order, and payment is authorized to Goodwill Industries of San Antonio for zone 1 and Due Amicis, Inc. d/b/a Green Landscaping for zone 2. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2016 and subsequent budgets that fall within the term period of this contract approved by City Council.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
