AN ORDINANCE 2016-02-11-0086

AUTHORIZING THE DESIGNATION OF A RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONE ON PORTIONS OF NORTH FLORES STREET NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF PARK COURT IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 1.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio created a Residential Only Parking Permit Program through Ordinance 2015-04-30-0359; and

WHEREAS, residents have submitted a petition for the creation of Residential Permit Parking Zone on certain public rights of way; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of this residential permit parking zone will provide a public benefit to the residents whose property fronts certain public rights of way; and

WHEREAS, unnecessary noise, pollution and strained relationships between neighborhood residents and non-residents will be reduced in the zone resulting in an increase of safety, tranquility, aesthetics and other values available in this residential environment; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. A Residential Permit Parking Zone is hereby created for the areas identified on **Exhibit I** along the 1700 and 1800 blocks of North Flores Street. Permit parking hours shall be weekdays between 7am-7pm. A permit is not required at any other time.

SECTION 2. Funds generated by this ordinance will be deposited into Fund 53001000, Internal Order 219000000129 and General Ledger 4403138.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance becomes effective 10 days after passage, unless it receives the eight votes requisite to immediate effectiveness under San Antonio Municipal Code § 1-15, in which case it becomes effective immediately.



EXHIBIT I

The RPP zone extends along N. Flores from 310 feet north of
Fredericksburg Road to 40 feet south of W. Myrtle. This
encompasses the 1703 N. Flores (SE corner of NCB 1918 BLK 2 LOT 3 AND 4 (U U VISTA
POINT SUBD)) to 1827 N Flores parcels (NE corner of NCB 1920 BLK 3 LOT S 44 FT OF E 106 FT OF A25).



The zone is from the centerline of the street to the adjoining property line, and does not include the right of way half in front of 800 West Myrtle.
