Brief Description of Item(s) and Use: This contract will provide on-call collision repair services for sedans and light-duty pickup trucks of all makes and models in the City's fleet. This contract will be utilized by Building and Equipment Services and will be awarded to multiple contracted vendors allowing for a more timely return of vehicles to service. There are approximately 2,820 mixed model sedans and light-duty pickup trucks in the City's fleet.
