On-Call Environmental Remediation Services (TCI) – Department issued a Request for Proposals seeking proposals from qualified firms to perform On-Call Environmental Remediation Services for various City projects in various locations throughout the City. Typical work to be performed under this On-Call Contract will consist of excavation, removal, transportation and disposal of

impacted soil and groundwater from City streets, drainage ways, City-owned property, Right-of-Way (hereafter referred to as "ROW") easements and other City-related remediation services.
