AN ORDINANCE 2016-03-31-0220

AUTHORIZING A TASK ORDER CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH CLARK CONSTRUCTION OF TEXAS, INC. IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,939,441.00 FOR 2016-2017 BIKE AND INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS, TRAFFIC CALMING AND VISION ZERO SAFETY PROJECTS THROUGHOUT THE CITY.

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WHEREAS, throughout each year, the Transportation and Capital Improvements Traffic Engineering Division is responsible for implementing various projects throughout the City from Infrastructure Management Program bike and intersection improvements to special traffic calming and Vision Zero pedestrian safety projects; and

WHEREAS, the demand for such projects has increased so dramatically that the existing Streets Division on-call contracts no longer can accommodate the Traffic Engineering Division projects; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by Clark Construction of Texas, Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$2,939,441.00 for a Task Order Contract for 2016-2017 bike and intersection improvements, traffic calming and Vision Zero safety projects throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, expenditures for these services are subject to available funding and are authorized by individual projects at the time work is requested or project funds are appropriated through Ordinance; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid of **Clark Construction of Texas, Inc.** in the amount not to exceed \$2,939,441.00 for installation of Traffic Signal Systems and other devices throughout the City is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first.

SECTION 2. A task order construction contract is hereby awarded to **Clark Construction of Texas, Inc.**

SECTION 3. The following financial adjustment is hereby approved:

a) Funding for this Ordinance will be identified when work orders are issued. If funding for any work orders is not previously appropriated, funding will be identified and appropriated through subsequent City Council action. Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with Operating and/or Capital Budgets for current and future fiscal years.

b) Payment not to exceed \$2,939,441.00 per annual contract is authorized to be encumbered with a purchase order and made payable to **Clark Construction of Texas, Inc.**, for engineering services throughout the City.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.

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SECTION 6. PASSED AND APPROVED this <u>31st</u> day of <u>March</u>, 2016.
