## AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE FOLLOWING CONTRACTS ESTABLISHING UNIT PRICES FOR GOODS AND SERVICES FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$892,000.00: (A) D & A TECHNOLOGY & DEVELOPMENT, INC. FOR TIRE RUBBER MODIFIED SURFACE SEAL, (B) E.J. WARD, INC. FOR E.J. WARD AUTOMATED FUEL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM, AND (C) RECORDED BOOKS, INC. FOR LIBRARY RECORDED BOOKS.

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio with commodities and services on an annual basis for the terms of the contracts; and

**WHEREAS**, these bids are from the following companies to furnish the City with: (A) D & A Technology & Development, Inc. for Tire Rubber Modified Surface Seal (B) E.J. Ward, Inc. for E.J. Ward automated fuel management system, and (C) Recorded Books, Inc. for library recorded books; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance approves one low bid contract and two contracts on the basis of sole source; and

**WHEREAS**, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE**:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The bids from the following companies to furnish the City with: (A) D & A Technology & Development, Inc. for Tire Rubber Modified Surface Seal (B) E.J. Ward, Inc. for E.J. Ward automated fuel management system, and (C) Recorded Books, Inc. for library recorded books for an estimated annual cost of \$892,000.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**. Copies of bids are available for inspection in the office of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.

**SECTION 2.** The amounts will be encumbered upon issuance of various purchase orders and payment is authorized to the vendors identified herein. All current fiscal year expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2016 budget approved by City Council and future fiscal year expenditures are contingent upon future City Council budget approvals.
