D/B/A ADVANCED WORKSTATIONS **EDUCATION FOR** EARLY LITERACY IN **STATIONS ACCESSORIES**; **AUTOMATED** & **(B)** CORPORATION FOR **BUILDING AUTOMATION SYSTEM** MAINTENANCE FOR VARIOUS FACILITIES; AND (C) ZOLL MEDICAL CORPORATION FOR ZOLL AED DEFIBRILLATORS & ACCESSORIES.

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WHEREAS, the City is able to obtain significant savings by purchasing various materials and services on an annual contract basis; and

WHEREAS, these bids are from various companies to furnish the City with: (A) AWE, Inc. d/b/a Advanced Workstations in Education for early literacy stations & accessories; (B) Automated Logic Corporation for building automation system maintenance for various facilities; and (C) Zoll Medical Corporation for Zoll AED defibrillators & accessories; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance approves three sole source contracts; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bids of various companies to furnish the City with (A) AWE, Inc. d/b/a Advanced Workstations in Education for early literacy stations & accessories; (B) Automated Logic Corporation for building automation system maintenance for various facilities; and (C) Zoll Medical Corporation for Zoll AED defibrillators & accessories on an annual contract basis as shown on the attached bid tabulation sheets, are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**. Copies of the contracts are available for inspection in the offices of the Finance Department, Purchasing Division.

SECTION 2. The amounts will be encumbered upon issuance of various purchase orders, and payment is authorized to the vendors identified herein. All current fiscal year expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2016 budget approved by City Council, and future fiscal year expenditures are contingent upon future City Council budget approvals.
