REQUEST:

The applicant is requesting a Certificate of Appropriateness for approval to install eight (8) flag-pylon “Flyon” signs in the right-of-way to mark VIA bus stops where a bus stop currently does exist. Each Flyon will measure 8’ x 1’-5,” made of aluminum. The eight proposed locations include:

1. Avenue E & Houston
2. Mission San Juan
3. Travis between Cameron & Santa Rosa
4. Hoefgen in front of S.P. Depot
5. Travis & Soledad
6. Travis & Flores
7. W Houston & San Saba
8. Travis & Jefferson

APPLICABLE CITATIONS:

Secretary of the Interior’s Standards for Rehabilitation:

9. New additions, exterior alterations, or related new construction will not destroy historic materials, features, and spatial relationships that characterize the property. The new work shall be differentiated from the old and will be compatible with the historic materials, features, size, scale and proportion, and massing to protect the integrity of the property and its environment.

FINDINGS:

- a. In June, VIA will be making changes to downtown, Broadway and Missions routes and branding. Three new VIVA routes will be branded as VIVA culture, VIVA missions, and VIVA centro. Existing stops that currently have other signage types will be replaced with the new Flyon signs.
- b. Primo Flyons signs were approved by the HDRC September 5, 2012.
- c. Staff finds each location to be appropriate in scale and materials. The proposed Flyon locations will not have an adverse effect on historic district or landmarks. This is consistent with the Secretary of Interior Standards 9.

RECOMMENDATION:

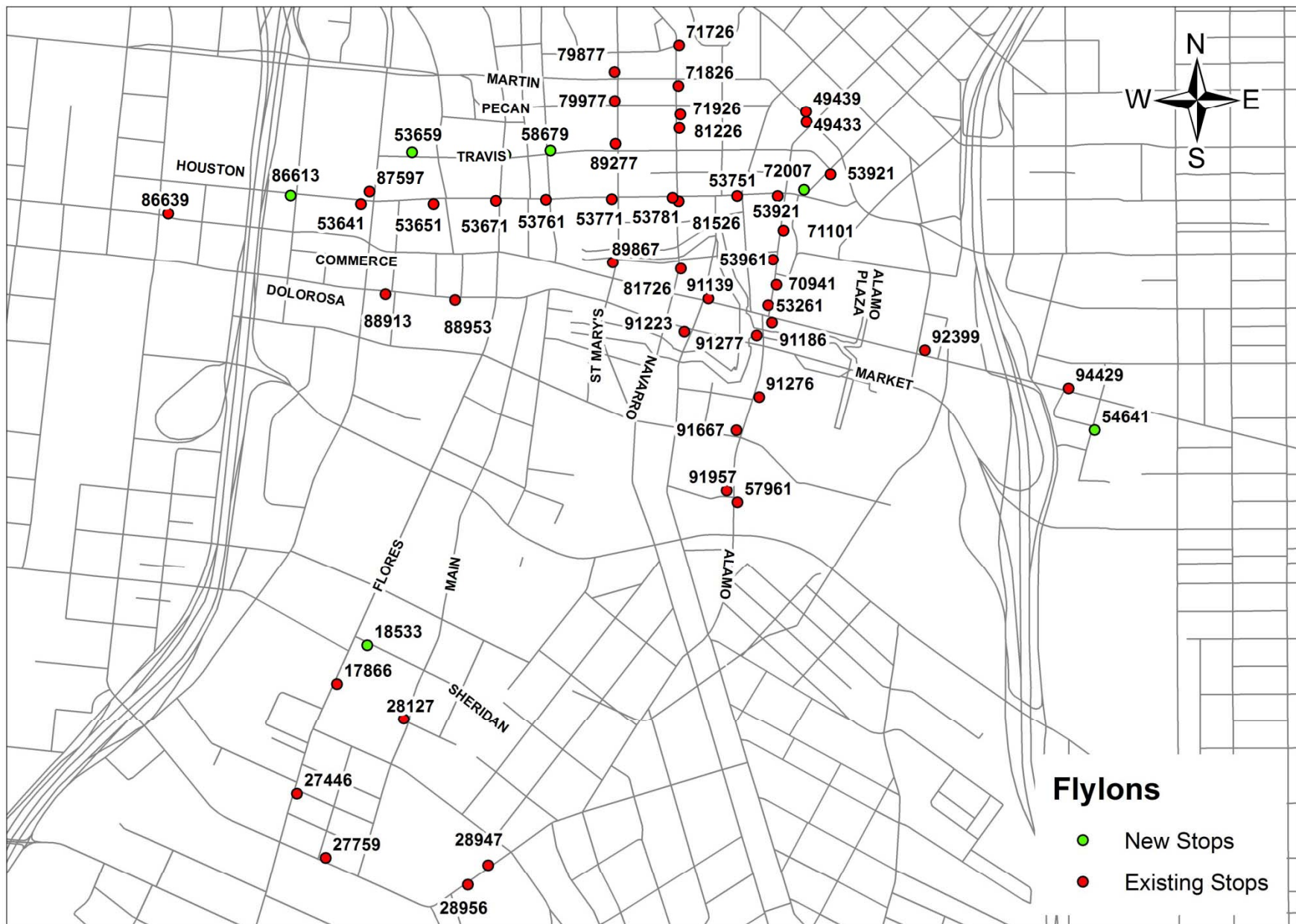
Staff recommends approval as submitted based on findings a through c.

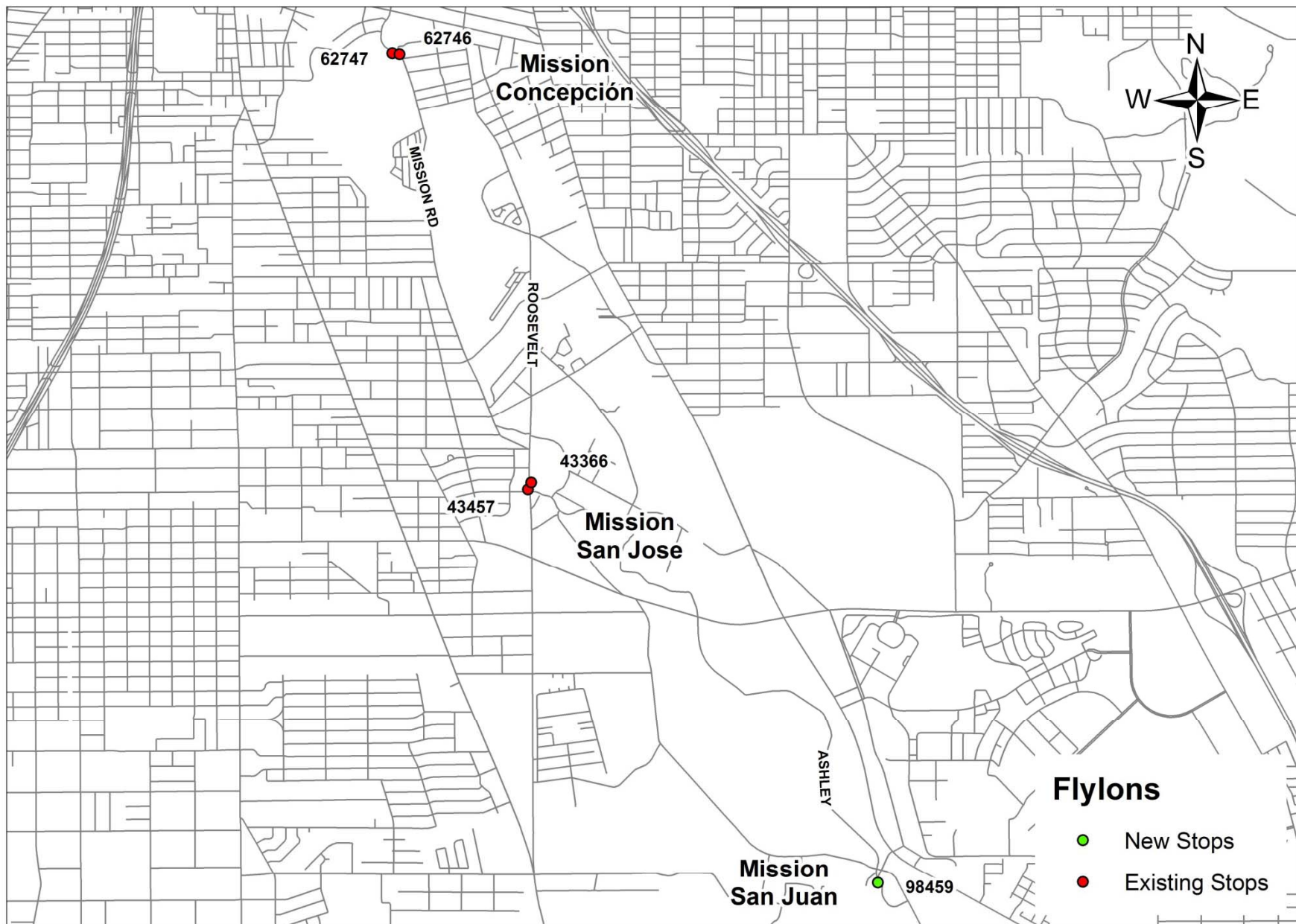

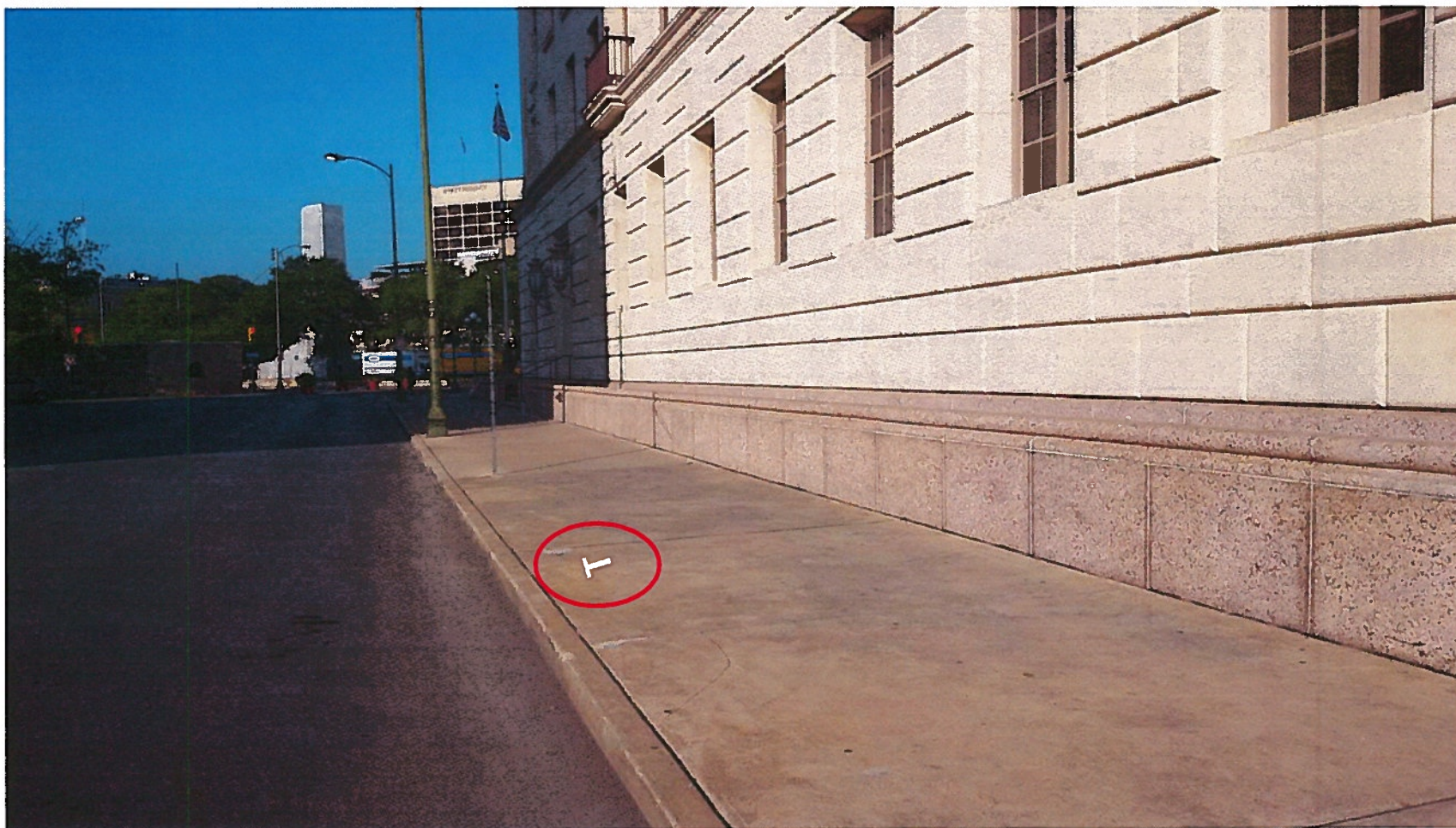

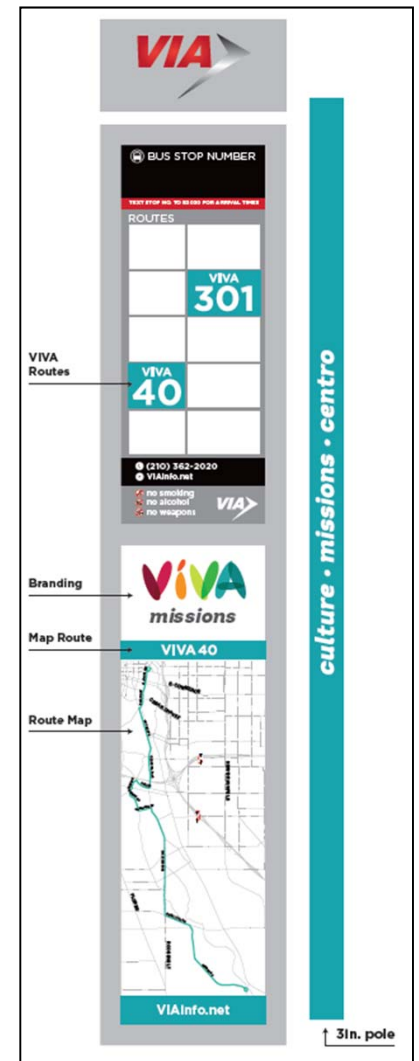
VIVA Routes

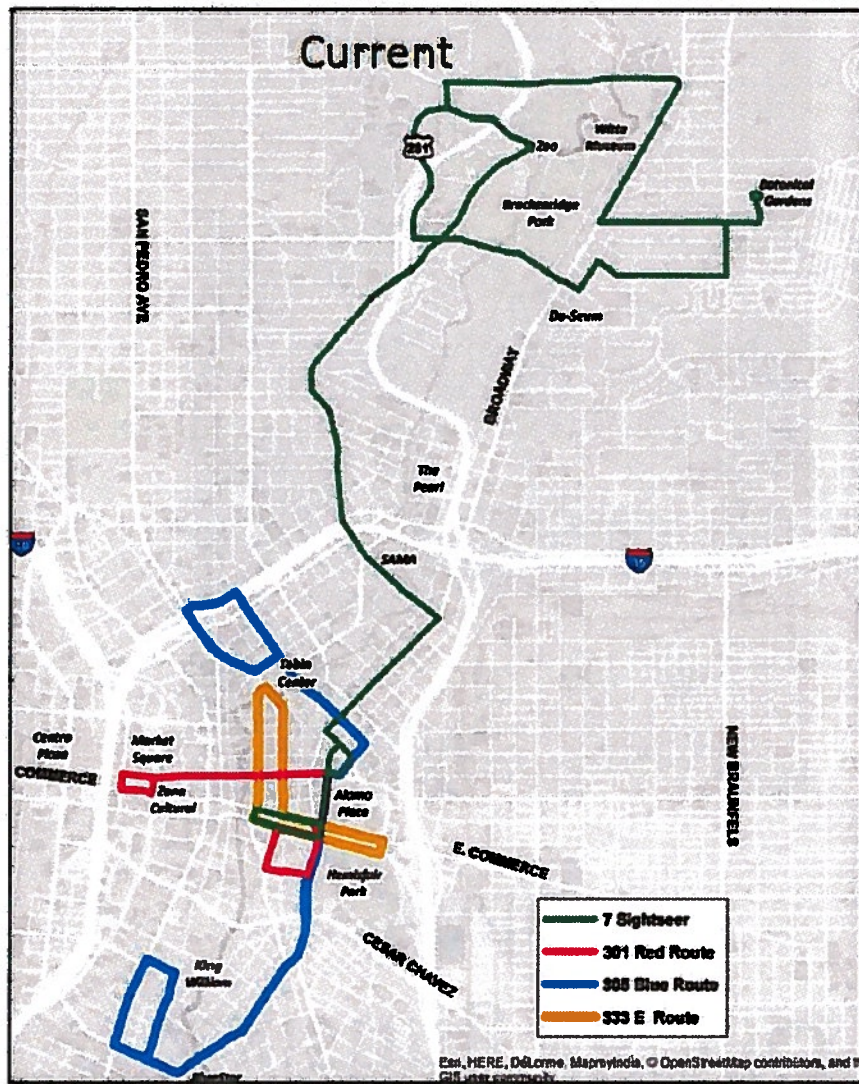

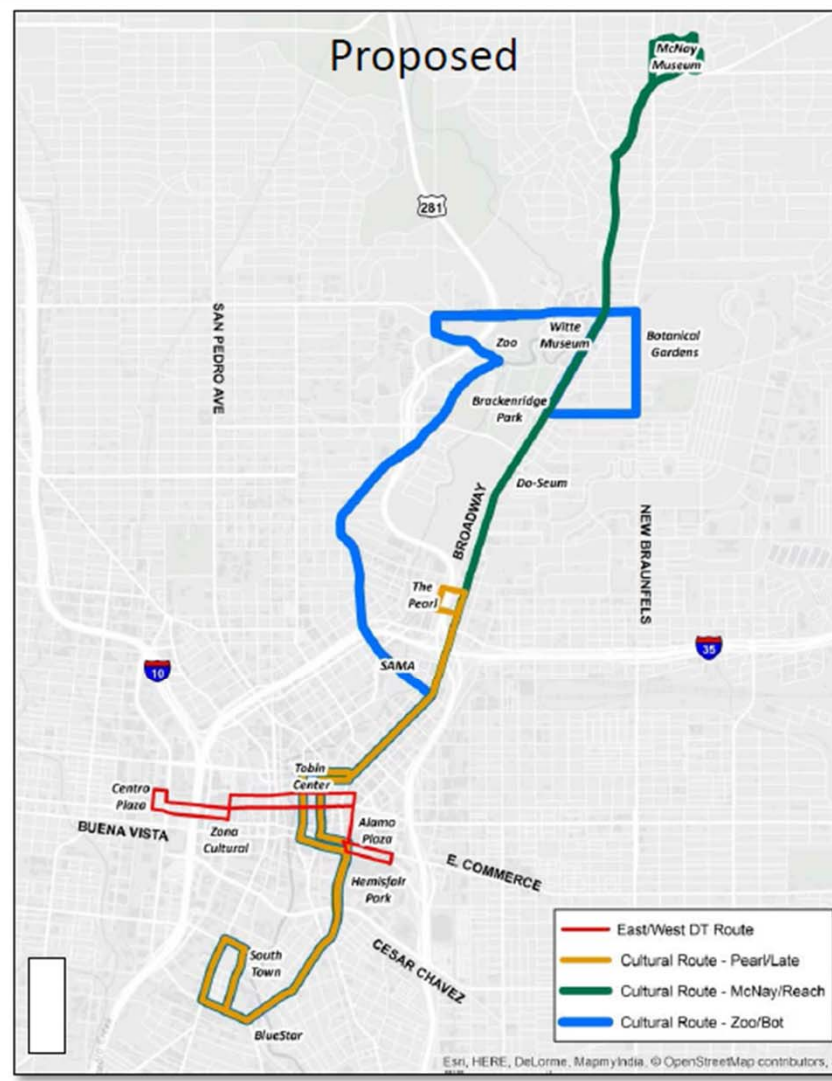

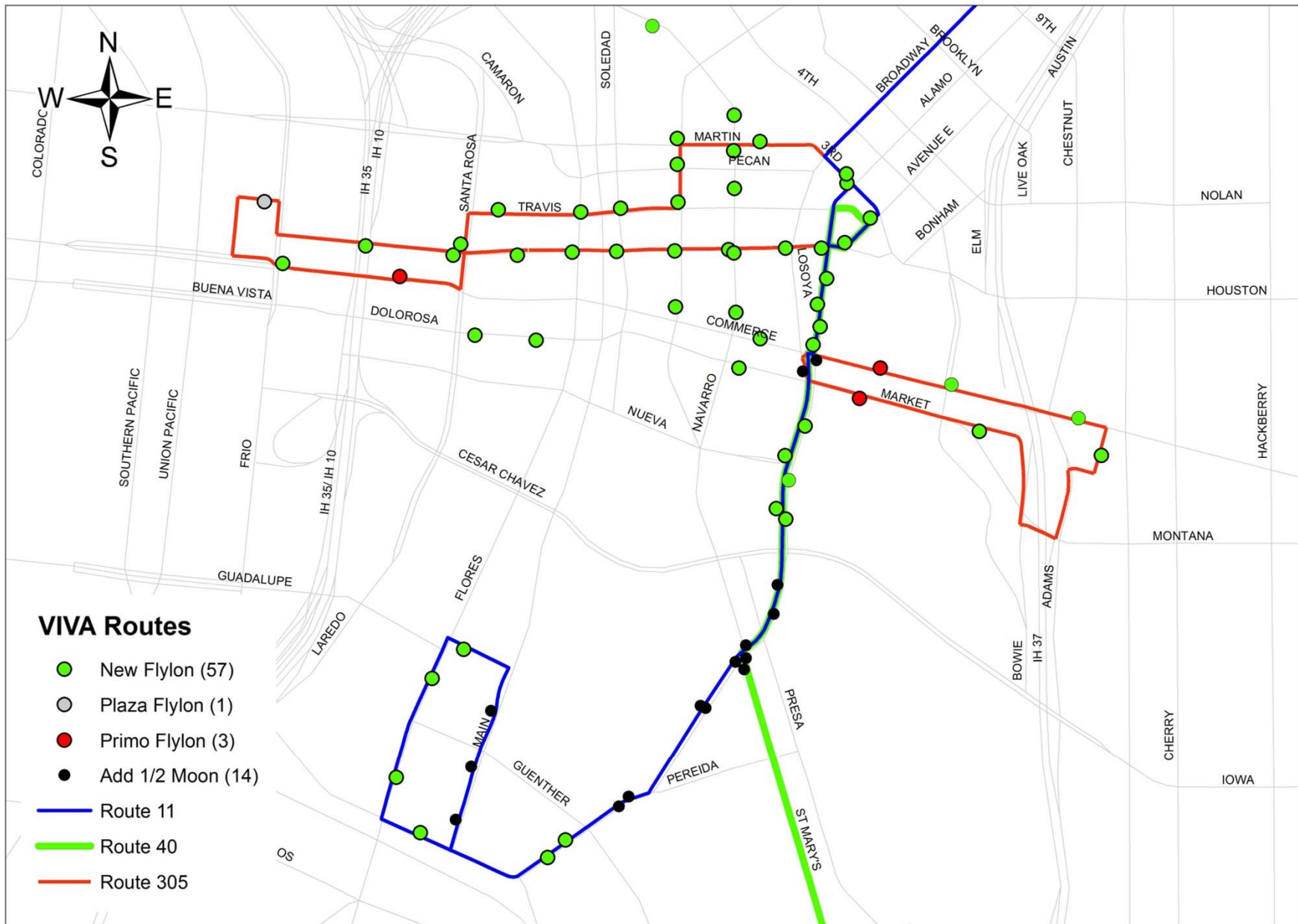

Existing and Proposed Broadway Service

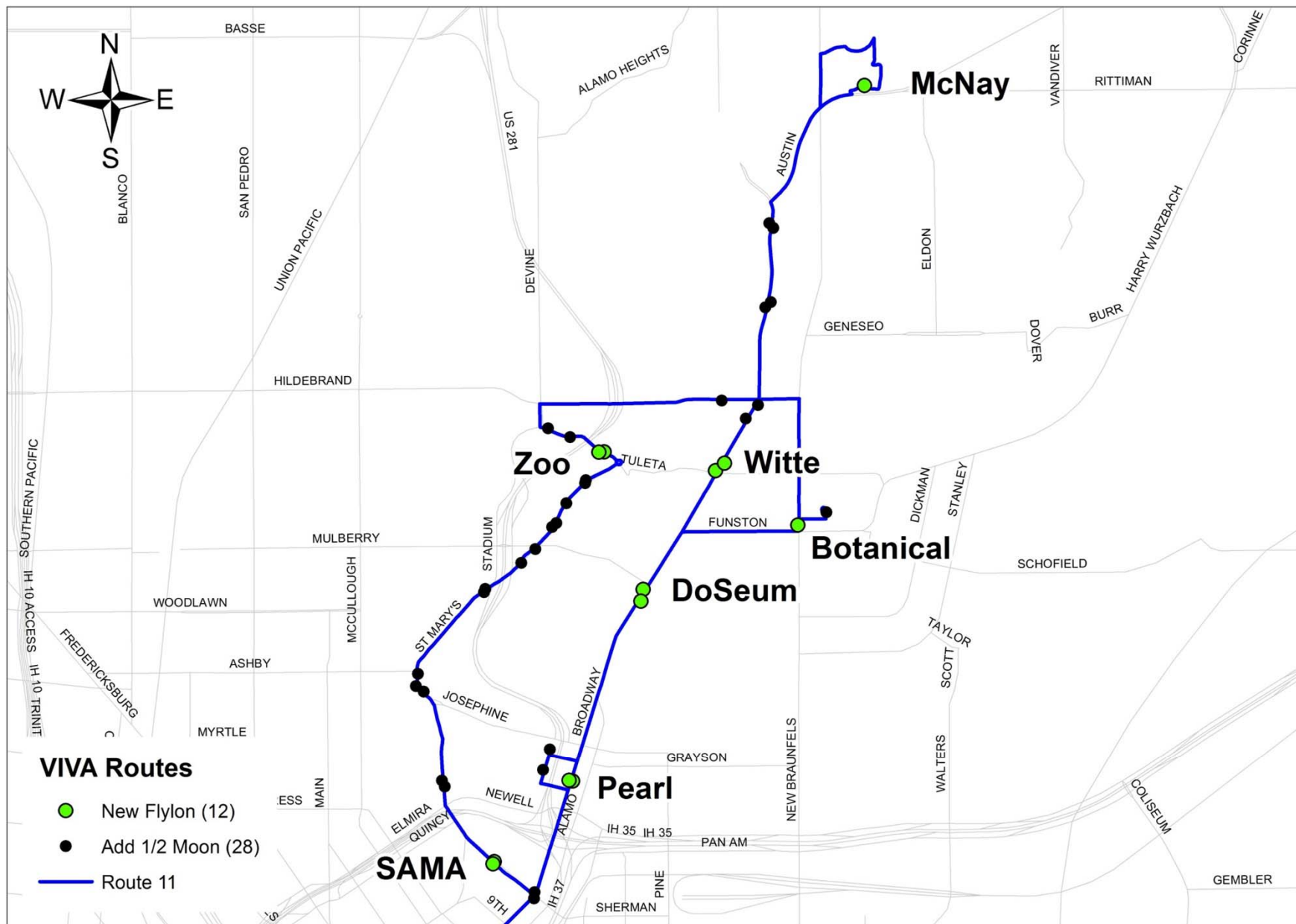


Existing and Proposed Broadway Service

REQUEST:

The applicant is requesting a Certificate of Appropriateness for approval to:

Install thirteen (13) flag-pylon "Flylon" signs to mark VIA bus rapid transit stops where a full bus rapid transit stop isn't used. Maps will vary by location, and the actual graphics used are yet to be determined. Each Flylon will measure approximately 8' x 11". Materials will consists of brushed aluminum and red, powder-coated aluminum.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff finds the proposed Flylons to be appropriate in scale and materials. The proposed Flylon locations will not have an adverse effect on any downtown historic districts or landmarks.

Staff recommends approval as submitted.
