AN ORDINANCE 2016-05-12-0344

AUTHORIZING THE FINAL ONE YEAR EXTENSION OF A CONTRACT WITH TRI-STARR PERSONNEL, LLC. TO PROVIDE STAFFING FOR THE CITY'S FIRE DEPARTMENT WELLNESS CENTER IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$300,000.00.

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Fire Department Wellness Center utilizes professional staffing from Tri-Starr Personnel, LLC, formerly Kenmark Staffing Group; and

WHEREAS, the First Extension of the original contract ends September 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to exercise the second one-year renewal option, beginning October 1, 2016 and ending September 30, 2017; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to execute an extension to the contract with Tri-Starr Personnel, LLC. for the period from October 1, 2016 to September 30, 2017, in an amount not to exceed \$300,000.00, as set forth in Attachment I. The terms of the Extension are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The amount up to \$300,000.00 will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to Tri-Starr Personnel, LLC. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2017 budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance becomes effective immediately if passed and approved by eight (8) affirmative votes; otherwise this Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days from the date of passage.

SECOND EXTENSION PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT TRI-STARR PERSONNEL, LLC.

This Extension of the Professional Services Contract for medical staff at the San Antonio Fire Department Wellness Center (the "Contract") is entered into by and between the City of San Antonio ("City") and Tri-Starr Personnel, LLC., is as follows:

WHEREAS, through Ordinance No. 2010-09-07-09-07-05, passed and approved on September 9, 2010, and amended through Ordinance No. 2012-09-06-0679 City Council authorized the execution of a five-year Contract with Tri-Starr Personnel, LLC., to provide medical staff and provided for two, one-year extensions at the City's option (the "Original Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the Original Contract provided for an initial term beginning upon signing and ending on September 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, through Ordinance No. 2015-06-18-0565 the City exercised its option for the first renewal option to extend the Original Contract for a one-year period beginning on October 1, 2015 and ending September 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City now wishes to exercise the second renewal option to extend the Original Contract for a one-year period beginning on October 1, 2016, and ending September 30, 2017; NOW, THEREFORE:

I. RENEWAL AND EXTENSION

The City hereby exercises its option to renew and extend the term of the Original Contract for an additional one (1) year period, commencing on October 1, 2016 and terminating September 30, 2017, such option having been granted to the City in Section VI, "TERM", in Section 6.1 of the PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT.

II. PROVISIONS REMAIN IN EFFECT

All other terms, conditions, covenants and provisions of the Original Contract, approved by Ordinance No. 2012-09-06-0679, not specifically mentioned herein and revised by this document, are hereby retained in their entirety, unchanged, and shall remain in full force in effect for the duration of said Original Contract.
