AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING THE OFFER FROM SILSBEE FORD TO PROVIDE FOUR REPLACEMENTS AND ONE ADDITIONAL FORD EXPLORER INTERCEPTOR SPORT UTILITY VEHICLES TO THE CITY'S FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$135,286.75, FUNDED FROM THE EQUIPMENT RENEWAL AND REPLACEMENT FUND AND THE FIRE DEPARTMENT'S GENERAL FUND.

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WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by Silsbee Ford, through the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative (a.k.a. the "Buyboard"), to provide the City with five Ford Explorer Interceptor Sport Utility Vehicles for a total cost of \$135,286.75; and

WHEREAS, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Ordinance No. 97097 on January 30, 2003; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The offer from Silsbee Ford to provide the City with five Ford Explorer Interceptor Sport Utility Vehicles for a total cost of \$135,286.75 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation and contract are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$135,286.75 for this ordinance is available as part of the Fiscal Year 2016 Budget per the table below:
