**AN ORDINANCE**

**AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$87,978.00 TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, BUREAU OF JUSTICE STATISTICS FOR THE TRANSITION TO THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION'S NATIONAL INCIDENT-BASED REPORTING SYSTEM; AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS, UPON AWARD.**

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**WHEREAS**, Section 411.054 of the Texas Government Code, a recently enacted provision, requires local law enforcement agencies to convert their incident-based reporting systems to the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS); and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) has grant funds available to the San Antonio Police Department (SAPD) in an amount up to \$87,978.00 to assist in this transition; and

**WHEREAS**, no City matching contribution is required; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to submit a grant application in an amount not to exceed \$87,978.00 to the DOJ for grant funds to assist SAPD in the transition to NIBRS. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to accept said grant, if awarded under the same terms and conditions as applied for. The City Manager and her designee are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said application and acceptance.

**SECTION 2.** Upon acceptance of this award, a new fund and internal order number will be created, upon which the sum of \$87,978.00 will be appropriated from DOJ. The proposed budget, which is attached hereto **Exhibit I**, is hereby approved.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the

City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts, as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
