Typical work to be performed under this On-Call Contract will consist of building design, design services for minor interior modifications, improved accessibility for the disabled, periodic field observation as required, development of recommendations for repairs and preparing plans and specifications for construction services.

Design Services for Terminal A/B Connector and Security Checkpoint Expansion (Aviation/TCI) — TCI issued a Request for Qualifications on behalf of Aviation seeking professional services to design a facility that connects the concourses of Terminal "A" and Terminal "B" on the ticket level of the terminal buildings. The estimated total size of the facility is roughly 80,000 square feet. A portion of the project is comprised of roughly 25,000 square feet of area to house the security screening checkpoint and passenger processing function for patrons entering the concourse of Terminal "A." The connector project shall connect Concourse "A" in the general area of the existing north food court and extend more than 1,500 feet to join the food court area of the ticket level of Concourse "B." The corridor shall be of adequate width to accommodate pedestrian and motorized people mover equipment such as moving sidewalks or man driven carts and dollies Escalators and elevators both public and service will be included as well as new public restrooms.
