FASTLANE16 GRANT

- In March 2016, the U.S. Department of Transportation sent out notice for the Nationally Significant Freight and Highway Projects NSFHP-16-FASTLANE16 Grant
- The City of San Antonio submitted a
 Technical Application for Zarzamora Street
 at Frio City Road Railroad Overpass in
 Council District 5
- Applications were due on April 14th







Project Background

- The project is in the proximity of Port San Antonio
- UPRR track cross the intersection along Zarzamora Street
 - 25.96 trains within 24 hour period
 - Train builds up a long queue in all 5-legs of the intersection
 - Average wait time = 6 minutes and 40 seconds







Project Benefits

- Project would include Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety intersection improvements
- Vehicular movements removed from rail crossing
- Project provides safety, travel time, emissions and livability benefits









Funding

- The FASTLANE16 grant provides 60% of funding for the project
- The grant will fund the environmental document, real estate, permits and design plans
- Grant will fund design to make the project shovel ready


