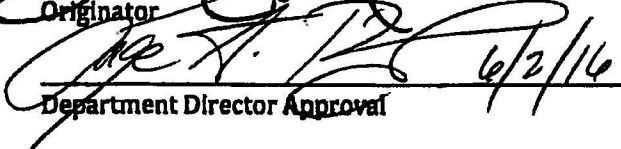

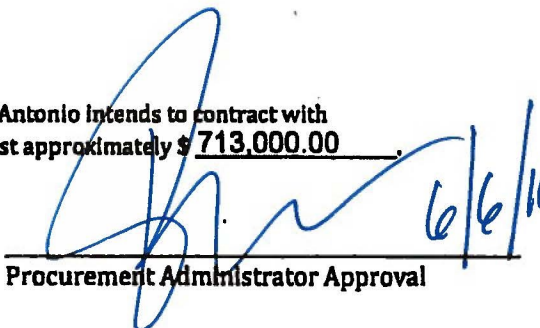
This Certificate of Exemption is executed and filed with the Finance Department as follows:

1. The undersigned is authorized to approve an exemption.
2. An exemption according to Section 252.022 of the Local Government Code exists. More specifically, the following event has occurred:

Due to the special nature of these units, each one provides a unique function in effort to protect the citizens of San Antonio. The Mobile Command Vehicle is a fully self-contained mobile command center and control center truck. It is designed for remote field operations or as a control facility for data acquisition and distribution. The Special Weapons and Tactics Teams (SWAT) Rapid Deployment Vehicle will be used by the SWAT team during potential terrorist related incidents as well as respond to critical emergency situations during all outside operational phases of a tactical response.

3. Because the exemption stated above exists, the City of San Antonio intends to contract with Doggett Freightliner & Mac Haik Df which will cost approximately \$ 713,000.00.
