AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING THE OFFER FROM COBAN TECHNOLOGIES, INC. TO PROVIDE REPLACEMENT IN-CAR VIDEO CAMERAS TO THE CITY'S POLICE DEPARTMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000,000.00, FUNDED FROM THE FY2016 TAX NOTES.

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WHEREAS, in October 2010, the San Antonio Police Department (SAPD) contracted with COBAN Technologies through the State of Texas DIR cooperative agreement to equip police patrol vehicles with mobile video and voice recording equipment installed in marked patrol vehicles; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide SAPD with an annual contract to replace COBAN In-Car Video units that are reaching end-of-life status; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The offer from with COBAN Technologies, Inc., utilizing the State of Texas Department of Information Resources DIR contract number DIR-TSO-2582 to provide replacement in-car video cameras to SAPD in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00, is hereby approved. A copy of the offer is attached hereto and is incorporated by reference as **Attachment I**. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute the agreement and any related documents in furtherance of the intent and purpose of this ordinance without further council approval.

SECTION 2. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage hereof.
