AN ORDINANCE 2016-06-16-0464

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION AND ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$13,800,000.00 FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE RESIDENTIAL ACOUSTICAL TREATMENT PROGRAM AT SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

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WHEREAS, the City regularly coordinates with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) for continued Airport Improvement Program (AIP) funding for eligible projects at San Antonio International Airport; and

WHEREAS, the FAA through the AIP has designated the City to receive FAA AIP Grant monies in the amount not to exceed \$13,800,000.00 to fund the continuation of the Residential Acoustical Treatment Program (RATP); and

WHEREAS, the FAA portion of the RATP grant would be \$11,040,000.00 with the City providing \$2,760,000.00 in matching funds from the Airport Improvement and Contingency Fund; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize the submission of the grant application, acceptance of the grant, and execution of the grant acceptance documents associated with the FAA AIP grant for the Residential Acoustical Treatment Program; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee, or the Aviation Director, is hereby authorized to submit and accept a grant application for up to \$11,040,000.00 from the FAA for the Residential Acoustical Treatment Program. The City will provide a cash match of \$2,760,000.00 from the Airport Improvement and Contingency Fund to provide a total project cost of \$13,800,000.00.

SECTION 2. Upon approval of this ordinance, new funds and internal order numbers will be created. A formal budget will also be provided once funds are awarded.

SECTION 3. The amount of \$11,040,000.00 is appropriated in SAP Fund 2605808330**XX**, Residential Acoustical Program, SAP Internal Order # 13300000001XX, SAP GL account 6102100 - Interfund Transfer out entitled from 2605808330XX to 33-00170-90-20-16. The amount of \$11,040,000.00 is authorized to be transferred to SAP Fund 51099000.

SECTION 4. The budget in SAP Fund 51099000, Airport Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 33-00170, Residential Acoustical Treatment Program, shall be revised by increasing

SECTION 5. The amount up to \$11,040,000.00 is appropriated in SAP Fund 51099000, Airport Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 33-00170, Residential Acoustical Treatment Program, SAP WBS Element 33-00170-05-07, entitled Unallocated Appropriations, SAP GL Account 5406530.

SECTION 6. The amount of \$2,760,000.00 is appropriated in SAP Fund 51013000, Capital Improvement S, SAP WBS AV-00006-01-01-87, SAP GL account 6102100 - Interfund Transfer out entitled Transfer to 33-00170-90-04. The amount of \$2,760,000.00 is authorized to be transferred to SAP Fund 51099000.

SECTION 7. The budget in SAP Fund 51099000, Airport Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 33-00170, Residential Acoustical Treatment Program, shall be revised by increasing SAP WBS element 33-00170-90-04 entitled Transfer from AV-00006-01-01-87, SAP GL account 6101100 - Interfund Transfer In, by the amount \$2,760,000.00.

SECTION 8. The amount up to \$2,760,000.00 is appropriated in SAP Fund 51099000, Airport Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 33-00170, Residential Acoustical Treatment Program, the budget shall be revised by increasing the SAP WBS Elements as follows:

SECTION 10. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.



 - With the FAA Reauthorization Bill expected to be extended for the 3rd time, efforts will continue to include a rider/amendment to allow International to use the 2009 FAA-approval boundaries, including the Neighborhood Equity areas of 2009.
