AN ORDINANCE 2016-06-16-0465

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THC, INC. IN THE INCREASED NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$13,800,000.00 SUBJECT TO RECEIPT AND EXECUTION OF THE NEW FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION GRANT FOR THE RESIDENTIAL ACOUSTICAL TREATMENT PROGRAM TO BE AWARDED IN SEPTEMBER 2016.

WHEREAS, City Council authorized the submittal of a grant application to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and acceptance of the grant offer for up to \$13,800,000.00 for the Residential Acoustical Treatment Program (RATP) which is managed by THC, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance will authorize the City Manager or her designee to amend the Professional Services Agreement with THC, Inc. in the increased amount not to exceed of \$13,800,000.00 upon receipt and execution of the new FAA grant offer for the RATP to be awarded in September 2016; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute an amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with THC, Inc. for the management of the Residential Acoustical Treatment increasing the contract value by up to \$13,800,000.00 subject to receipt and execution of the Federal Aviation Administration grant offer for the Residential Acoustical Treatment Program to be awarded in 2016.

SECTION 2. This ordinance authorizes an amendment to the professional services agreement with THC, Inc. (THC) in the amount of \$13,800,000.00. THC is the Acoustical Treatment Consultant that manages the noise abatement program including all design, construction and legal components.

SECTION 3. This amendment will be funded by the grant application and City match referenced in the companion ordinance considered by City Council on this same day. Upon acceptance of this award, a fund and internal order number will be assigned, upon which the sum of \$13,800,000.00 will be appropriated. Payment is authorized to THC upon issuance of a Purchase Order.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation

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Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
