Engineering/manufacturing software and training will be provided via an Online Learning Center with unlimited access for employees by way of a terminal server environment. The software system serves as the primary in-house design format package for Traffic, Stormwater, and Project Management Divisions of Transportation and Capital Improvements. The Bentley program package is used to create in-house storm water designs, review plats, review building permits and analyze floodplain models. In addition, the package will be utilized in Capital Improvement Projects to create future projects and address City Council requests.

These items are being purchased as Sole Source according to the provisions of Texas Statutes Local Government Code 252.022.07. No other source can supply the items listed nor can any comparable item fulfill the same requirements.
