Call To Order

Chairwoman Mendoza called the meeting to order.

1. Recognition of outgoing Boardmember Dr. Linda Foster, District 10 Appointee [Elaine Mendoza, Pre-K 4 SA Board Chair; Kathy Bruck, Pre-K 4 SA CEO]

Chairwoman Mendoza recognized Dr. Foster's experience and dedication as she leaves the Pre-K 4 SA Board. A gift of recognition was given to her on behalf of Pre-K 4 SA and the Board. Outgoing Boardmember Foster acknowledged and appreciated the time she served on the Board.

Boardmember Perez entered in at this time.

 Induction of Phillip Thomson, District 10 Appointee and reappointment and swearing-in of Board Members Pam Ray, District 2 Appointee; Richard Perez, District 4 Appointee; Lucy Hall, District 6Appointee; Dr. Shari Albright, District 8 Appointee [Elaine Mendoza, Pre-K 4 SA Board Chair; Leticia Vacek, City Clerk]

Chairwoman Mendoza introduced the newly incoming Boardmember Thomson and he briefly mentioned his background.

Chairwoman Mendoza identified the even-numbered District Boardmembers would need to be reappointed and the new Boardmember Thomson would need to be sworn in as per bylaws. Leticia Vacek of The Office of City Clerk swore in all required boardmembers.

Chairwoman Mendoza brought to everyone's attention that under Boardmember Dickson's leadership, Ms. Bruck was honored by the Texas A&M College of Education award in May.

3. Approval of minutes of the March 29, 2016 and April 5, 2016 Early Childhood Education Municipal Development Corporation Board of Directors Meetings

Boardmember Perez moved to approve the March 29, 2016 and April 5, 2016 Early Childhood Education Municipal Development Corporation Board of Directors Meeting Minutes. Boardmember Ramirez seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously by those present.

City Manager Sculley entered in at this time.

CEO Interviews

4. Board review and interview of Chief Executive Officer candidate and possible Board action [Elaine Mendoza, Board Chair; Joe Robles, Personnel Committee Chair; Sheryl Sculley, City Manager]

Dr. Baray entered the room at this time for her interview with the Board.

Executive Session

5. Conduct full-Board interview of CEO candidate and discuss personnel matters pursuant to Texas Government Code Sections 551.071(consultation with attorney) and 551.074 (personnel matters).

Chairwoman Mendoza recessed the Early Childhood Education Municipal Development Corporation Board of Directors Meeting into Executive Session at 2:10 pm. She reconvened the meeting at 3:02 pm and announced the Board review and interview of Chief Executive Officer Candidate and Board action.

Chairwoman Mendoza announced the Board's decision to select Dr. Baray for the Chief Executive Officer.

Boardmember Perez moved to approve the decision to select Dr. Baray for the Chief Executive Officer for Pre-K 4 SA. Boardmember Dickson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously by those present.

Chairwoman Mendoza welcomed Dr. Baray as the CEO of Pre-K 4 SA. Dr. Baray was grateful for

the opportunity and looking forward to working with the board.

Individual Briefings

6. Briefing of Westat approach to working with TEA to obtain comparative analysis [Kathy Bruck, Pre-K 4 SA CEO]

Ms. Bruck gave a briefing of the Literacy Kindergarten Entry Assessment (KEA) 2014/15 for Pre-K 4 SA Cohort 1 (attended in 2013/14).

Boardmember Middleton questioned if the information was requested from the TEA Commissioner.

Ms. Bruck responded that the information was requested through public information requests. Boardmember Middleton mentioned there should be communication with the commissioner.

Chairwoman Mendoza introduced Dr. Woodrow from Westat to let her speak on the process. Dr. Woodrow stated the TEA data is limited.

Dr. Woodrow mentioned the Year 1 study conducted by NIEER. The assessment was limited to one content area and could not reflect general content area because of the way assessments are structured.

Ms. Bruck continued the conversation on continuing with the public information request this summer and looking for other possibilities for obtaining the data. The Board discussed the importance of the data and future options for obtaining the data.

Boardmember Ramirez commented that the tests assess sound, symbol, and association; they do not test oral language development which is critical for early childhood development.

Boardmember Ramirez suggested utilizing recitation of poetry. Boardmember Guzman explained how children can express themselves in memorizing poetry and simplifying things in their own words.

Dr. Woodrow acknowledged the critical skills at the prekindergarten age including oral language, social, and emotional development.

Boardmember Ray referred to thinking outside of the box with the methodology for comparing with the school districts and the non-traditional nature of Pre-K 4 SA. Dr. Woodrow agreed and mentioned that Westat has met with an advisory group for expert recommendations to provide to Pre-K 4 SA.

No action was required for item 6.

7. Briefing and Board approval of the redesigned Pre-K 4 SA logo and tagline [Paul Chapman, Pre-K 4 SA Communications Manager]

Mr. Chapman gave a briefing on the redesigned Pre-K 4 SA logo and tagline.

Mr. Chapman requested the Board's approval to move forward with logo and tagline. The Board entered into a discussion of the various components of the logo.

Boardmember Middleton motioned to approve the redesigned Pre-K 4 SA logo and tagline. Boardmember Dickson seconded the motion. The motion carried by the following vote:
