
#### Abstract

ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID INCLUDING AN ADDITIVE ALTERNATE AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO E-Z BEL CONSTRUCTION LLC. IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$745,988.62 TO RECONSTRUCT THE INTERSECTION AT $36{ }^{\text {TH }}$ STREET AND BANGOR AS PART OF THE $36^{\text {TH }}$ STREET AND BANGOR PROJECT LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 7.


WHEREAS, on May 12, 2012, voters approved the 2012-2017 Bond Program, which authorized $\$ 1,100,000.00$ for the $36^{\text {th }}$ Street and Bangor Drive Intersection Project and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid including an additive alternate submitted by E-Z Bel Construction, LLC, in the amount not to exceed $\$ 745,988.62$ to reconstruct the intersection at $36^{\text {th }}$ Street and Bangor as part of the $36^{\text {th }}$ Street and Bangor Project; and

WHEREAS, this provides for reconstruction and widening of $36^{\text {th }}$ Street to a five lane roadway with left-turn lanes, curbs, sidewalks, driveway approaches, and traffic-signal improvements; and

WHEREAS, the additive alternate places pedestrian railing along top of drain on the eastside of $36^{\text {th }}$ Street to provide a safety measure for citizens walking on sidewalk; and

WHEREAS, this is a one-time capital improvement expenditure in the amount not to exceed $\$ 745,988.62$ for which funds are available from the 2012 General Obligation Bonds and are included in the FY 2016-2021 Capital Improvement Budget; NOW THEREFORE,

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid of E-Z Bel Construction, LLC in the amount not to exceed $\$ 745,988.62$ for the $36^{\text {th }}$ Street and Bangor Project is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first.

SECTION 2. A construction contract is hereby awarded to E-Z Bel Construction, LLC.
SECTION 3. Payment in the amount of $\$ 745,988.62$ in SAP Fund 45099000 , General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00286, 36th Street \& Bangor Drive Intersection, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to E-Z Bel Construction, LLC, for construction services.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence
by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.
