This Certificate of Exemption is executed and filed with the Finance Department as follows:

- 1. The undersigned is authorized to approve an exemption.
- 2. An exemption according to Section 252.022 of the Local Government Code exists. More specifically, the following event has occurred:

The Aviation Department is seeking a subscription to Dilo, a web-based aviation data portal, to provide domestic and international market data that is critical to the Airport's efforts to attract new flights. The subscription will include the following modules: 1) Mir (Worldwide Airline Schedule data); 2) "FMd" (Domestic Market Size Data); 3) "FMI (International Market Size Data); and 4) "QSI" (forecasting tool). Dilo LLC has a naturally occurring monopoly based on proprietary copyrighted material using algorithm searches. The Aviation Department seeks to issue a Request for Offer (RFO) to Dilo LLC on the basis of a sole source exemption due to Dilo being the sole provider of Dilo Mi and its FMd, FMi, and QSi components and their support. Diio is also the only provider that brings all datasets and tools together in a single one-stop service. Estimated annual costs are \$46,000.00 with a total contract value of \$230,000.00 for three years and two 1 year renewals.

3. Because the exemption stated above exists, the City of San Antonio intends to contract with Diio, LLC which will cost approximately \$ 230,000 (5yrs)
