## AN ORDINANCE 2016-08-18-0638

## AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO BY AMENDING CHAPTER 35, UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE, SECTION 35-304, OF THE CITY CODE OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS BY CHANGING THE ZONING DISTRICT BOUNDARY OF CERTAIN PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held after notice and publication regarding this amendment to the Official Zoning Map at which time parties in interest and citizens were given an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Commission has submitted a final report to the City Council regarding this amendment to the Official Zoning Map of the City of San Antonio; NOW THEREFORE,

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Chapter 35, Unified Development Code, Section 35-304, Official Zoning Map, of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas is amended by changing the zoning district boundary of 114.149 acres out of NCB 14890 from "R-6 MLOD" Residential Single-Family Camp Bullis Military Lighting Overlay District to "MPCD MLOD" Master Planned Community Camp Bullis Military Lighting Overlay District.

SECTION 2. A description of the property is attached as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 3. The City council approves this Master Planned Community District so long as the attached site plan is adhered to. A site plan is attached as Exhibit "B" and made a part hereof and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 4. All other provisions of Chapter 35 except those expressly amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect including the penalties for violations as made and provided for in Section $35-491$.

SECTION 5. The Director of Development Services shall change the zoning records and maps in accordance with this ordinance and the same shall be available and open to the public for inspection.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall become effective the $28^{\text {th }}$ day of August 2016.

Southeasterly, along a non-tangent curve to the left, said curve having a radius of 1188.92 feet, a central angle of $53^{\circ} 34^{\prime} 09^{\prime \prime}$, a chord bearing and distance of S $54^{\circ} 03^{\prime} 01^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}, 1071.55$ feet, for an arc length of 1111.59 feet to a found Texas Department of Transportation Type II monument;
$\mathrm{S} 80^{\circ} 48^{\prime} 38^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, a distance of 683.50 feet to a found Texas Department of Transportation Type II monument;

Southeasterly, along a non-tangent curve to the left, said curve having a radius of 1188.92 feet, a central angle of $17^{\circ} 28^{\prime} 17^{\prime \prime}$, a chord bearing and distance of S $89^{\circ} 33^{\prime} 43^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}, 361.14$ feet, for an arc length of 362.54 feet to a set $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ iron rod with a yellow cap marked "Pape-Dawson", at the northwest corner of said Lot 3;

THENCE: $\quad \mathrm{S} 06^{\circ} 40^{\prime} 22^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, departing the south right-of-way line of said UTSA Boulevard, along and with the west line of said Lot 3 , a distance of 249.78 feet to a set $1 / 2$ " iron rod with a yellow cap marked "Pape-Dawson", at the southwest corner of said Lot 3;

THENCE: $\quad$ N $80^{\circ} 24^{\prime} 13^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$, along and with the south line of said Lot 3 , a distance of 393.65 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING, and containing 114.149 acres in the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas.
