

AN ORDINANCE **2016-09-01-0643**

ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID AND AWARDING A TASK ORDER CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO SIGNAL SERVICES GROUP INC., IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,422,062.50 FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL EQUIPMENT AT NUMEROUS LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT THE CITY FOR PROJECTS TO BE IDENTIFIED IN THE FY 2017 – FY 2021 IMP AND ADDITIONAL PROJECTS THAT MATERIALIZE THROUGHOUT THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT.

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WHEREAS, this contract will be primarily utilized to complete the installation of traffic signal equipment identified in the 2017 IMPs, along with additional projects that may materialize throughout the contract term; and

WHEREAS, this contract provides for equipment modifications to include, but not limited to the installation of traffic signal equipment such as traffic signal heads, audible pedestrian signals, traffic signal controller cabinets, vehicle detection devices, light emitting diode (LED) change outs, and any other related work; and

WHEREAS, the hardware for these modifications is being purchased and furnished by the Transportation and Capital Improvements Department and will be provided to the Contractor for each location; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by **Signal Services Group, Inc.**, for an amount not to exceed \$1,422,062.50 for the installation of traffic signal equipment at numerous locations throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, funding for these modifications will be made available through various funding sources which may include, but is not limited to, Street Maintenance Program (SMP), General Fund and Neighborhood Access and Mobility Program (NAMP); and

WHEREAS, any funding for traffic signal equipment modification that was not previously appropriated will be identified and appropriated through subsequent City Council actions; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid of **Signal Services Group, Inc.** in the amount not to exceed \$1,422,062.50 for the installation of traffic signal equipment at numerous locations throughout the City for projects to be identified in the FY 2017 - FY 2021 IMP and additional projects that materialize throughout the term of the contract is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first.

SECTION 2. A Task Order construction contract is hereby awarded to **Signal Services Group, Inc.**

SECTION 3. The following financial adjustments are hereby approved:

- a) Funding for this ordinance will be identified when work orders are issued. If funding for any work orders is not previously appropriated, funding will be identified and appropriated through subsequent City Council action. Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with Operating and/or Capital Budgets for current and future fiscal years.
- b) Payment not to exceed \$1,422,062.50 per contract term, is authorized to be encumbered with a purchase order and made payable to **Signal Services Group Inc.**, for the installation of traffic signal equipment at numerous locations throughout the City for projects to be identified in the FY 2017 - FY 2021 IMP and additional projects that materialize throughout the term of the contract.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.
