

AN ORDINANCE **2016-09-15-0706**

**AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION
TO THE TEXAS 1033 SURPLUS PROPERTY PROGRAM
TO ENABLE THE SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT
TO RECEIVE PROPERTY DISPERSED TO LAW
ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT
OF DEFENSE.**

WHEREAS, Section 1033 of the National Defense Authorization Act permits the Secretary of Defense to transfer to state and local law enforcement agencies personal property of the Department of Defense which the secretary determines is suitable for use by law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Army National Guard administers the program, the Texas 1033 Surplus Property Program, that implements the authority granted to the secretary in Texas; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to submit an application to that agency in order to participate in the program; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to submit an application to the Texas 1033 Surplus Property Program to enable the San Antonio Police Department to receive property dispersed to law enforcement agencies by the U.S. Department of Defense.


SECTION 2. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.


