AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING A LOCAL ADMINISTRATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES PARTICIPATING IN THE TEXAS ANTI-GANG PROGRAM.

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WHEREAS, the Texas Anti-Gang Program is a multi-agency task force that will combat gang activity in the area; and

WHEREAS, the agencies that will be participating in the TAG Program include the San Antonio Police Department; the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives; the U.S. Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration; the Texas Department of Public Safety; the U.S. Department of Justice, Federal Bureau of Investigation; the Bexar County District Attorney's Office; the Bexar County Sheriff's Office; the U.S. Marshals Service; the U.S. Department of Homeland Security Investigations; the United States Attorney's Office; and the Office of the Inspector General, Texas Department of Criminal Justice; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the participating agencies enter into a local administrative agreement to provide for the administration of the TAG Program; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to execute the local administrative agreement attached hereto as Exhibit I, or one substantially similar to said agreement, with the participating agencies to provide for the administration of the Texas Anti-Gang Program.

SECTION 2. The budget for the TAG Program shall not exceed \$2,000,000.00 for the period of April 1, 2016, to August 31, 2017. Fund 2205517001 (Texas Anti Gang 2016) and Internal Order 117000000218 are hereby designated for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the execution of this agreement.

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SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts, as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
