<p>San Antonio Police Department is applying for the FY16 Enhanced Collaborative Model to Combat Human Trafficking Grant in the amount of \$650,000 with an in-kind match of \$216,667 for the purpose of enhancing anti-human trafficking law enforcement, victim services to victims of human trafficking, conducting both proactive and reactive investigations of sex trafficking crimes, and to enhance the established task force in coordination and collaboration with other law enforcement agencies and non-governmental agencies.</p> <p>This grant will strengthen the working relationship between the Police Department and the Rape Crisis Center for Children and Adults in order to provide a victim-centered approach for addressing this rapidly growing crime. SAPD and Rape Crisis Center will work to enhance a multi-disciplinary approach of identifying and investigating occurrences of human trafficking in order to prosecute both the traffickers and those who benefit from the services forced to be provided by the victims, meet the individual needs of the victims, and to conduct public awareness of this problem within our community and surrounding areas to prevent future incidents of human trafficking.</p>
