AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH VIA METROPOLITAN TRANSIT TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT DURING A STATE ACTIVATION.

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WHEREAS, the San Antonio Office of Emergency Management (SAOEM) provides coordination and support in response to statewide manmade or natural disasters; and

WHEREAS, in that regard, it is necessary that SAOEM arrange for emergency transportation to shelter sites and various support centers during such disasters; and

WHEREAS, SAOEM wishes to enter into an interlocal agreement with VIA Metropolitan Transit to provide emergency transportation services for the period January 1, 2017, through December 31, 2017, with automatic annual extensions through December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the annual estimated cost of such services is \$300,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the costs incurred in connection with this agreement will be reimbursed by the Texas Department of Emergency Management; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to execute an interlocal agreement with VIA Metropolitan Transit to provide emergency transportation services, at an annual estimated cost of \$300,000.00, during statewide manmade or natural disasters that contains substantially the same terms and conditions as those contained in **Exhibit I**. Should the parties fail to execute an agreement within ninety days of the effective date of this Ordinance, subsequent City Council authorization will be required.

SECTION 2. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount up to \$300,000.00 is authorized to VIA Metropolitan Transit from the Texas Department of Emergency Management and should be

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encumbered with a purchase order. An internal order number and specific fund will be created, should this agreement become active, and will be covered by emergency management funds

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts, as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
