AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES AND ACCEPTANCE UPON AWARD OF \$995,828.00 FOR THE PERIOD OF SEPTEMBER 30, 2017 TO SEPTEMBER 29, 2018 FOR THE BEXAR CARES PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING A BUDGET, INCLUDING AN IN-KIND MATCH OF \$995,828.00, AND PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT FOR 2018.

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WHEREAS, since 2014, the City's Department of Human Services (DHS) has operated the Bexar Cares Program with the Center for Health Care Services, with funds awarded by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, for years 1-3 of a four-year grant period to work with child welfare, juvenile justice, education and mental health providers in an effort to integrate resources, increase access, and better address the comprehensive needs of children with serious emotional disturbances; and

WHEREAS, DHS now seeks authorization to apply and accept funds for year 4 of the four-year grant period; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee, or the Director of the Department of Human Services (DHS) or her designee, is authorized to submit an application to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) and accept upon award \$995,828.00 for the period September 30, 2017 to September 29, 2018 for the Bexar CARES Program to provide services to children with emotional disturbances and their families. A copy of the application is on file with the DHS.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or her designee, or the Director of the DHS or her designee, is further authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate the grant application and acceptance of funds and to apply for and accept additional funds, if available, so long as any required match is also available.

SECTION 3. A proposed budget, including an in-kind match of \$995,828.00, is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**. A formal final budget which will include Internal Order numbers, General Ledger numbers, and a department specific fund will be submitted by the department upon award.

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SECTION 4. The proposed personnel complement of one grant-funded position, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment II**, is hereby approved.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or her designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
