

US 281 North Residential Area



State Requirements

- Cities are required to:
 - Provide written notification to property owners and public entities
 - Hold 2 public hearings by City Council
 - Develop "Service Plan" and available by first City Council public hearing



Service Plan

- Municipality must provide:
 - Police
 - Fire & Emergency Medical Service
 - Solid Waste
 - Operation and Maintenance
 - Water and wastewater facilities
 - Public roads and streets (street lighting)
 - Parks and recreation facilities
 - Other publicly-owned facility (or service)
 - Capital Improvements
 - Necessary acquisition or construction of capital improvements
- Final Service plan adopted at time annexation ordinance is adopted





Timeline of Annexation Procedures

- September 8, 2016 Council action on Municipal Annexation Plan
- September December Conduct inventory of services
- December 2016 Complete service plan
- January February 2017 Negotiate services in lieu of annexation agreement through appointment of 5 representatives by Bexar County Commissioner's Court
- January 11 First City Council public hearing
- February 1 Second City Council public hearing
- March 2 City Council considers agreement postponing annexation to 2034
