AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES WITHIN THE ALAMO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS REGION FOR COORDINATION OF EMERGENCY SERVICES DUE TO OCCASIONAL SHORTAGES OF EMERGENCY SERVICES EQUIPMENT, PERSONNEL OR NEED FOR SPECIALIZED EQUIPMENT OR RESOURCES.

WHEREAS, there is a need among neighboring governmental entities to provide for mutual aid in the event of an emergency due to occasional shortages of emergency services equipment, personnel or need for specialized equipment or resources; and

WHEREAS, the governmental entities lying wholly or partially within the geographic area covered by the Alamo Area Council of Governments (AACOG) wish to enter into a regional mutual aid agreement for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Alamo Area Fire Chiefs Association will serve as the administrative agency under the agreement; and

WHEREAS, such an agreement is authorized by Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, Chapter 418 of the Texas Government Code, Chapter 421 of the Texas Government Code, and Chapter 362 of the Texas Local Government Code; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to execute the Alamo Area Emergency Services Mutual Aid Agreement attached hereto as **Exhibit I** or an agreement that is substantially the same as that attached hereto.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
