

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION FROM THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO TO THE CITY OF CONVERSE OF APPROXIMATELY 600 ACRES GENERALLY LOCATED NORTHWEST OF THE INTERSECTION OF EAST LOOP 1604 NORTH AND IH-10 EAST.

WHEREAS, the City of Converse has requested the release of approximately 600 acres from the extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ) of the City of San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Converse to gain this 600 acres of ETJ area generally located northwest of the intersection of East Loop 1604 North and Interstate Highway 10 East, more particularly described in the metes and bounds in **ATTACHMENT I**; and

WHEREAS, annexation by the City of San Antonio is not a viable option in the near future based on the location of subject area and the difficulty to provide municipal services; and

WHEREAS, if subject area is placed in Converse's ETJ, the City of Converse will annex the territory and provide municipal services to the area; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City of San Antonio has considered the proposed release of the property from the San Antonio ETJ on February 22, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the request from the City of Converse to release approximately 600 acres from the City of San Antonio ETJ; **NOW THEREFORE**;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The property containing approximately 600 acres, as more particularly described in the metes and bounds in **ATTACHMENT I** attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes, is hereby released from the Extraterritorial Jurisdiction of the City of San Antonio to the City of Converse.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.
