ZONING CASE # Z2017033 S ERZD (Council District 9): A request for a change in zoning from "C-2 MLOD-1 ERZD" Commercial Camp Bullis Military Lighting Overlay Edwards Recharge Zone District to "C-2 S MLOD-1 ERZD" Commercial Camp Bullis Military Lighting Overlay Edwards Recharge Zone District with Specific Use Authorization for a Hotel on Lot P-5A, P-8A, P-10, P-11, NCB 15671, located in the 2800 Block of North Loop 1604 East. Staff recommends Approval.

Staff mailed 27 notices to the surrounding property owners, 6 returned in favor, and 14 returned in opposition. Staff received two (2) petitions with a total of 349 signatures in opposition.

The representative also stated he has met with the surrounding community to reach agreements, however the neighborhood is in a strong opposition.

<u>Marietta Hill</u>, spoke in opposition, and presented a petition with 115 signatures in opposition from the surrounding area.

David Braunstein, spoke in opposition and stated the hotel is not appropriate for the area.

Leigh McMullian, spoke in opposition and stated the hotel is not appropriate for the area.
