**AN ORDINANCE**

**AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO, AND ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS, FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE SAFE AND THRIVING COMMUNITIES: PLANNING AND COLLABORATION IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$333,000.00 FOR 18 MONTHS BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2017, AND AUTHORIZING A PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT.**

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**WHEREAS**, on May 15, 2014, City Council authorized the San Antonio Police Department (SAPD) and the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) to accept an invitation only grant award in the amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.00 from the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division to support the Cure Violence Project, known locally as Stand Up S.A., beginning March 1, 2014 and ending September 30, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, an initial award amount of \$977,372.00 for the first 19 months, January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2016, was approved for initial exploration, training, and hiring the proposed personnel complement; and

**WHEREAS**, Stand Up S.A. is a program designed to prevent violence by treating the issue like an infectious disease; and

**WHEREAS**, the program is based on the Cure Violence model, an evidenced-based public health approach to reduce and prevent violence in our streets; and

**WHEREAS**, Stand Up S.A. focuses on interrupting transmission, changing behaviors and community norms; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed ordinance continues City Council's policy of seeking intergovernmental financial assistance for City crime prevention and enforcement programs addressing violent crime and gang activity; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant will provide the City the funding to develop a strategic plan to address youth related gun crime and gang violence; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or her designee is hereby authorized to submit a grant application to the U.S. Department of Justice and accept funds upon award in an amount up to \$333,000.00 for

participation in the Safe and Thriving Communities: Planning and Collaboration for 18 months beginning October 1, 2017. A copy of said application which is incorporated herein for all purposes is on file with the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or her designee is hereby authorized to initiate, negotiate, and execute any and all necessary documents and a grant contract to effectuate the acceptance of the referenced grant funds, and to execute contract amendments pertaining to this contract, to include: a) carry-over funds, when ascertained and approved by the funding agency through a revised notice of award; b) line item budget revisions authorized by the funding agency; c) modifications to the performance measures authorized by the funding agency and listed in the contract so long as the terms of the amendment stay within the general parameters of the intent of the grant; d) no cost extensions; e) amendments which will provide supplemental grant funds to the grant by the funding agency in an amount up to 20% of the total amount awarded to the grant inclusive of the amount accepted through this ordinance; f) reimbursement increases of administrative funds for each participant served; g) amendments funding one time equipment purchases or defined program services; and h) changes in state regulations mandated by the funding agency.

**SECTION 3.** Upon approval, a new fund and internal order will be created for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant and a sum not to exceed \$333,000.00 will be appropriated in said fund. The proposed budget which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I** is approved and adopted for entry in the City books. A formal final budget which will include Internal Order numbers and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the department upon acceptance of award.

**SECTION 4.** The proposed personnel complement of one (1) position which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Attachment I** is hereby approved. Should funding be awarded, the personnel complement is approved. The Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or his designee is further authorized to change personnel complement classifications within the approved personnel complement number so long as there is no increase to the overall budget.

**SECTION 5.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 6.** This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
