AN ORDINANCE

**AMENDING CHAPTER 6 OF THE CITY CODE OF SAN ANTONIO,
TEXAS, TO ESTABLISH A FIVE YEAR WAITING PERIOD AFTER A
STREET HAS BEEN RENAMED OR MEMORIAL DESIGNATION
ADDED BEFORE A SUBSEQUENT REQUEST FOR A STREET NAME
CHANGE OR MEMORIAL DESIGNATION IS FILED.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Chapter 6, Division 6, Sec. 6-674 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas, is amended to add a subsection (e) (underlined below). All other provisions remain the same.

Sec. 6-674. - Commencement of the process for changing the name of a street and/or adding the designation of a memorial name.

* * * * *

(e) From the date of the respective City Council action, a segment of street that City Council has approved for change of name or addition of memorial designation may not be altered for a period of five (5) years.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective 10 days after passage.
