AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A CONTINUATION GRANT APPLICATION IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$792,617.00 AND A MODIFIED GRANT APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT UP TO \$696,035.00, TO THE TEXAS AUTOMOBILE BURGLARY AND THEFT PREVENTION AUTHORITY FOR THE REGIONAL AUTO CRIMES TEAM PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS, UPON AWARD; AUTHORIZING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND THE BEXAR COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE RELATED TO THE GRANT APPLICATIONS; AND APPROVING A CASH MATCH OF \$471,831.00 AND AN IN KIND CONTRIBUTION OF \$2,215,720.00 FOR THE CONTINUATION GRANT, AND A CASH MATCH OF \$175,343.00 FOR THE MODIFIED GRANT.

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WHEREAS, the Texas Automobile Burglary and Theft Prevention Authority (ABTPA) has grant funds available to fund the Regional Auto Crimes Team (ReACT); and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Police Department wishes to apply for grant funds for that purpose in an amount not to exceed \$792,617.00 to continue an existing grant, which would require a cash match of \$471,831.00 and an in kind contribution of \$2,215,720.00; and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Police Department wishes to apply for grant funds for that purpose in an amount not to exceed \$696,035.00 to modify an existing grant, which would require a cash match of \$175,343.00; and

WHEREAS, the grant period would be September 1, 2017, to August 31, 2018; and

WHEREAS, award of the grant will necessitate the execution of an agreement with the Bexar County Sheriff's Office; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to submit two grant applications in amounts not to exceed \$792,617.00 and \$696,035.00 to the ABTPA to fund the ReACT for the period September 1, 2017, to August 31, 2018. The City Manager and her designee are hereby authorized to accept said grant, if awarded under the same terms and conditions as applied for. The City Manager and her designee are further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said application and acceptance.

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SECTION 2. Upon acceptance of one or both awards, new fund and internal order numbers will be created and the award of amounts not to exceed \$792,617.00 and \$696,035.00 from the ABTPA will be appropriated in said funds. The proposed budgets and personnel complements attached hereto as **Exhibit I** and **Exhibit II**, respectively, are hereby approved.

SECTION 3. Upon acceptance of this award, the City manager and her designee are hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the Bexar County Sheriff's Office in connection with the ReACT. The agreement shall contain the same or substantially similar terms and conditions as those contained in the agreement attached hereto as **Exhibit III**.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
