Background

CITY OF SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT

- ResCare Workforce Services serves as a contractor for Workforce Solutions Alamo and administers the Work Experience (WE) program.
- ResCare Workforce Services has funding available to provide the WIC Program with needed summer staffing through the WE program.

Background

CITY OF SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT

- During summer months, in addition to normal WIC services, WIC also provides breakfast and lunch to WIC participants through the Summer Feeding Program.
- ResCare Workforce Solutions will provide and pay staff to administer the program in exchange for training and work experience for their participating staff members





Fiscal Impact

• The agreement will provide a cost savings of \$160,380 in temporary worker salaries for the WIC grant. Metro Health will record the in kind value for the temporary workers for a term effective upon Council approval through August 31, 2018.

• There is no impact to the General Fund



Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of an ordinance to authorize an agreement between the Metro Health and ResCare Workforce Services for a term effective upon Council approval and execution through August 31, 2018.
