INTEGRATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS AND DIGITAL MARKETS INC., (D/B/A VISTA COM)

FOR PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF LOGGING RECORDERS FOR THE SAN ANTONIO PUBLIC SAFETY RADIO SYSTEM

This Agreement is entered into by and between the City of San Antonio, Texas, a home-rule municipal corporation (City), and Digital Markets Inc., D/B/A Vista Com (Vista Com), both of which may be referred to herein collectively as the "Parties".

The Parties hereto severally and collectively agree, and by the execution hereof are bound, to the mutual obligations herein contained and to the performance and accomplishment of the tasks hereinafter described.

1.0 CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

- 1.1 The terms and conditions for performance and payment of compensation for this Agreement are set forth in the following contract documents, true and correct copies of which are attached hereto and fully incorporated herein for all purposes, and shall be interpreted in the order of priority as appears below:
 - a. This Integration Agreement;
 - b. City's Request for Proposal (RFP) 6100008561, including all attachments, addendums, best and final offers, and clarification statements thereto (Exhibit A);
 - c. Vista Com Statement of Work/Payment/Fee Schedule (Exhibit B); and
 - d. Response of Vista Com to RFP 6100008561 (Exhibit C).

2.0 TERM

This Agreement will be for a one (1) year base period. The City shall have the option to renew for eight (8), additional one (1) year periods upon City Council approval. Approvals for renewals shall be made in writing by the Finance Director.

3.0 INSURANCE

Prior to the commencement of any work under this Agreement, Vista Com shall furnish copies of all required endorsements and completed Certificate(s) of Insurance to the City's Finance Department, Purchasing Division, which shall be clearly labeled "<u>PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF LOGGING RECORDER</u>" in the Description of Operations block of the Certificate. The Certificate(s) shall be completed by an agent and signed by a person authorized by that insurer to bind coverage on its behalf. The City will not accept a Memorandum of Insurance or Binder as proof of insurance. The certificate(s) must be signed by the Authorized Representative of the carrier, and list the agent's signature and phone number. The certificate should be mailed, with copies of all applicable endorsements, directly from the insurer's authorized representative to the City. The City shall have no duty to pay or perform under this Agreement until such certificate and endorsements have been received and approved by the City's Finance Department, Purchasing Division. No officer or employee, other than the City's Risk Manager, shall have authority to waive this requirement.

The City reserves the right to review the insurance requirements of this Article during the effective period of this Agreement and any extension or renewal hereof and to modify insurance coverages and their limits when deemed necessary and prudent by City's Risk Manager based upon changes in statutory law, court decisions, or circumstances surrounding this Agreement. In no instance will City allow modification whereby City may incur increased risk.

Vista Com's financial integrity is of interest to the City; therefore, subject to Vista Com's right to maintain reasonable deductibles in such amounts as are approved by the City, Vista Com shall obtain and maintain in full force and effect for the duration of this Agreement, and any extension hereof, at Vista Com's sole expense, insurance coverage written on an occurrence basis, unless otherwise indicated, by companies authorized to do business in the State of Texas and with an A.M Best's rating of no less than A- (VII), in the following types and for an amount not less than the amount listed below:

Vista Com agrees to require, by written contract, that all subcontractors providing goods or services hereunder obtain the same categories of insurance coverage required of Vista Com herein, and provide a certificate of insurance and endorsement that names the Vista Com and the CITY as additional insureds. Policy limits of the coverages carried by subcontractors will be determined as a business decision of Vista Com. Vista Com shall provide the CITY with said certificate and endorsement prior to the commencement of any work by the subcontractor. This provision may be modified by City's Risk Manager, without subsequent City Council approval, when deemed necessary and prudent, based upon changes in statutory law, court decisions, or circumstances surrounding this agreement. Such modification may be enacted by letter signed by City's Risk Manager, which shall become a part of the contract for all purposes.

As they apply to the limits required by the City, the City shall be entitled, upon request and without expense, to receive copies of the policies, declaration page, and all required endorsements. Vista Com shall be required to comply with any such requests and shall submit requested documents to City at the address provided below within 10 days. Vista Com shall pay any costs incurred resulting from provision of said documents.

Vista Com agrees that with respect to the above required insurance, all insurance policies are to contain or be endorsed to contain the following provisions:

- Name the City, its officers, officials, employees, volunteers, and elected representatives as <u>additional insureds</u> by endorsement, as respects operations and activities of, or on behalf of, the named insured performed under contract with the City, with the exception of the workers' compensation and professional liability policies;
- Provide for an endorsement that the "other insurance" clause shall not apply to the City of San Antonio where the City is an additional insured shown on the policy;
- Workers' compensation, employers' liability, general liability and automobile liability policies will provide a waiver of subrogation in favor of the City.
- Provide advance written notice directly to City of any suspension or non-renewal in coverage, and not less than ten (10) calendar days advance notice for nonpayment of premium.

Within five (5) calendar days of a suspension, cancellation or non-renewal of coverage, Vista Com shall provide a replacement Certificate of Insurance and applicable endorsements to City. City shall have the option to suspend Vista Com's performance should there be a lapse in coverage at any time during this contract. Failure to provide and to maintain the required insurance shall constitute a material breach of this Agreement.

In addition to any other remedies the City may have upon Vista Com's failure to provide and maintain any insurance or policy endorsements to the extent and within the time herein required, the City shall have the right to order Vista Com to stop work hereunder, and/or withhold any payment(s) which become due to Vista Com hereunder until Vista Com demonstrates compliance with the requirements hereof.

Nothing herein contained shall be construed as limiting in any way the extent to which Vista Com may be held responsible for payments of damages to persons or property resulting from Vista Com's or its subcontractors' performance of the work covered under this Agreement.

It is agreed that Vista Com's insurance shall be deemed primary and non-contributory with respect to any insurance or self insurance carried by the City of San Antonio for liability arising out of operations under this Agreement.

It is understood and agreed that the insurance required is in addition to and separate from any other obligation contained in this Agreement and that no claim or action by or on behalf of the City shall be limited to insurance coverage provided..

Vista Com and any Subcontractors are responsible for all damage to their own equipment and/or property.

4.0 INDEMNIFICATION

VISTA COM COVENANTS AND AGREES TO FULLY INDEMNIFY, DEFEND AND HOLD HARMLESS, THE CITY AND THE ELECTED OFFICIALS, EMPLOYEES, OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, VOLUNTEERS AND REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CITY, INDIVIDUALLY AND COLLECTIVELY, FROM AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL COSTS, CLAIMS, LIENS, DAMAGES, LOSSES, EXPENSES, FEES, FINES, PENALTIES, PROCEEDINGS, ACTIONS, DEMANDS, CAUSES OF ACTION, LIABILITY AND SUITS OF ANY KIND AND NATURE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, PERSONAL OR BODILY INJURY, DEATH AND PROPERTY DAMAGE, MADE UPON THE CITY DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY ARISING OUT OF, RESULTING FROM OR RELATED TO VISTA COM'S ACTIVITIES UNDER THIS AGREEMENT, INCLUDING ANY ACTS OR OMISSIONS OF VISTA COM, ANY AGENT, **OFFICER.** DIRECTOR. REPRESENTATIVE, EMPLOYEE, CONSULTANT OR SUBCONTRACTOR OF VISTA COM, AND THEIR RESPECTIVE OFFICERS, AGENTS EMPLOYEES, DIRECTORS AND REPRESENTATIVES WHILE IN THE EXERCISE OF THE RIGHTS OR PERFORMANCE OF THE DUTIES UNDER THIS AGREEMENT. THE INDEMNITY PROVIDED FOR IN THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL NOT APPLY TO ANY LIABILITY RESULTING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF CITY, ITS OFFICERS OR EMPLOYEES, IN INSTANCES WHERE SUCH NEGLIGENCE CAUSES PERSONAL INJURY, DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE. IN THE EVENT VISTA COM AND CITY ARE FOUND JOINTLY LIABLE BY A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION, LIABILITY SHALL BE APPORTIONED COMPARATIVELY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAWS FOR THE STATE OF TEXAS, WITHOUT, HOWEVER, WAIVING ANY GOVERNMENTAL IMMUNITY AVAILABLE TO THE CITY UNDER TEXAS LAW AND WITHOUT WAIVING ANY DEFENSES OF THE PARTIES UNDER TEXAS LAW.

The provisions of this INDEMNITY are solely for the benefit of the parties hereto and not intended to create or grant any rights, contractual or otherwise, to any other person or entity. Vista Com shall advise the CITY in writing within 24 hours of any claim or demand against the CITY or Vista Com known to Vista Com related to or arising out of Vista Com's activities under this AGREEMENT and shall see to the

investigation and defense of such claim or demand at Vista Com's cost. The CITY shall have the right, at its option and at its own expense, to participate in such defense without relieving Vista Com of any of its obligations under this paragraph.

5.0 TERMINATION

- 5.1 For purposes of this Agreement, "termination" of this Agreement shall mean termination by expiration of the Agreement term as stated, or earlier termination pursuant to any of the provisions hereof.
- 5.2 <u>Termination Without Cause.</u> This Agreement may be terminated by City upon 30 calendar days written notice. In the event of such termination by City, City shall pay Vista Com for all work executed and materials delivered to City in accordance with this Agreement, and costs incurred by reason of such termination.
- 5.3 Termination For Cause. Upon written notice, either party may terminate this Agreement as of the date provided in the notice, in whole or in part, upon the occurrence of one (1) or more of the following events, each of which shall constitute an Event for Cause under this Agreement:
 - 5.3.1 The sale, transfer, pledge, conveyance or assignment of this Agreement without prior approval, which shall not be reasonably be withheld,
 - 5.3.2 City's failure for a period of thirty (30) days to pay Vista Com for service and/or materials under of this Agreement.
- 5.4 Defaults With Opportunity for Cure. Should Vista Com default in the performance of this Agreement in a manner, same shall be considered an event of default. City shall deliver written notice of said default specifying such matter(s) in default. Vista Com shall have thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of the written notice to cure such default. If Vista Com fails to cure the default within such thirty-day cure period, City shall have the right, without further notice, to terminate this Agreement in whole or in part as City deems appropriate, and to contract with Vista Com to complete the work required in this Agreement. City shall also have the right to offset the cost of said new Agreement with any subsequent vendor against Vista Com future or unpaid invoice(s), subject to the duty on the part of City to mitigate its losses to the extent required by law.
 - 5.4.1 Bankruptcy or selling substantially all of company's assets
 - 5.4.2 Failing to perform or failing to comply with any covenant herein required
 - 5.4.3 Performing unsatisfactorily.
 - 5.4.4 Failure to meet acceptance test criteria approval on the third attempt.
- 5.5 <u>Termination By Law.</u> If any state or federal law or regulation is enacted or promulgated which prohibits the performance of any of the duties herein, or, if any law is interpreted to prohibit such performance, this Agreement shall automatically terminate as of the effective date of such prohibition.

- 5.6 Regardless of how this Agreement is terminated, Vista Com shall affect an orderly transfer to City or to such person(s) or firm(s) as the City may designate, at no additional cost to City, all completed or partially completed documents, papers, records, charts, reports, and any other materials or information produced as a result of or pertaining to the services rendered by Vista Com, or provided to Vista Com, hereunder, regardless of storage medium, if so requested by City, or shall otherwise be retained by Vista Com. Payment of compensation due or to become due to Vista Com is conditioned upon delivery of all such documents, if requested.
- 5.7 <u>Termination not sole remedy</u>. In no event shall City's action of terminating this Agreement, whether for cause or otherwise, be deemed an election of City's remedies, nor shall such termination limit, in any way, at law or at equity, City's right to seek damages from or otherwise pursue Vista Com for any default hereunder or other action.
- 5.8 If funding for the entire Agreement is not appropriated at the time this Agreement is entered into, City retains the right to terminate this Agreement at the expiration of each of City's budget periods, and any subsequent contract period is subject to and contingent upon such appropriation. In the event of such termination by City, Vista Com shall be entitled to payment in full for all work which Vista Com has performed in accordance with this Agreement and all equipment which Vista Com has delivered to the City pursuant to this Agreement.

6.0 LAW APPLICABLE

6.1 THIS CONTRACT SHALL BE CONSTRUED UNDER AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS AND ALL OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES CREATED HEREUNDER ARE PERFORMABLE IN BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS.

6.2 Any legal action or proceeding brought or maintained, directly or indirectly, as a result of this Contract shall be heard and determined in the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas.

7.0 ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement, together with its exhibits, if any, constitutes the final and entire agreement between the parties hereto and contains all of the terms and conditions agreed upon. No other agreements, oral or otherwise, regarding the subject matter of this Agreement shall be deemed to exist or to bind the parties hereto, unless the same are in writing, dated subsequent to the date hereto, and duly executed by the parties.
