

AN ORDINANCE 2017-06-08-0426

AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000.00 TO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH ALAMO ENVIRONMENTAL, INC. DBA ALAMO 1 FOR ON-CALL ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION SERVICES FOR THE SAN ANTONIO AIRPORT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, in January 2013, the City executed a Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with Alamo Environmental, Inc., dba Alamo 1 for on-call environmental remediation services for the San Antonio Airport System (herein called the "Agreement") in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends and City Council desires to increase the budget for this PSA by up to \$200,000.00 for additional services; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the PSA accordingly and authorize the execution of such an amendment; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The terms and conditions of an amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with Alamo Environmental, Inc., dba Alamo 1, as described above are hereby approved. The City Manager or her designee is authorized to execute the amendment, a copy of which in substantially final form is attached as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funding for this Ordinance will be identified when work orders are issued. If funding for any work orders is not previously appropriated, funding will be identified and appropriated through subsequent City Council action. Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with Operating and/or Capital Budgets for current and future fiscal years.


SECTION 3. Payment not to exceed \$200,000.00 is authorized to be encumbered with a purchase order and made payable to Alamo Environmental, Inc. (dba Alamo 1), to provide on-call, environmental remediation services for the San Antonio Airport System.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**AMENDMENT NO. 1
TO THE
ON-CALL ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION SERVICES AGREEMENT
FOR
THE SAN ANTONIO AIRPORT SYSTEM**

This Amendment (herein called the "Amendment") to the On-Call Environmental Remediation Services Agreement for the San Antonio Airport System is entered into by and between the City of San Antonio (herein called the "City"), a Texas municipal corporation, acting by and through its City Manager, and Alamo Environmental Inc. dba Alamo1 (hereinafter called "Consultant"), both of which may be referred to herein collectively as the "Parties", as set out below. WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the City and Consultant, as a result of a formal solicitation process, entered into the On-Call Environmental Remediation Services Agreement for the San Antonio Airport System ("Agreement") pursuant to Ordinance No. 2013-01-17-0027; and

WHEREAS, this Amendment increases the not to exceed contract capacity by \$200,000.00; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms, covenants, agreements and demises herein contained, and in consideration of other good and valuable consideration, each to the other given, the sufficiency and receipt of which are hereby acknowledged, the Agreement entered into by and between the City and the Consultant is amended as follows:

Article II, Compensation. The not to exceed contract amount set out in Article II, Compensation is hereby increased by \$200,000.00 for a revised maximum not to exceed amount of \$1,200,000.00.

Except as amended hereby, all other provisions of the Agreement are hereby retained in their entirety and remain unchanged.
