AN ORDINANCE

**AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THC, INC. IN THE
INCREASED NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$6,060,000.00 SUBJECT
TO RECEIPT AND EXECUTION OF THE NEW FEDERAL AVIATION
ADMINISTRATION GRANT FOR THE RESIDENTIAL ACOUSTICAL
TREATMENT PROGRAM TO BE AWARDED IN 2017.**

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WHEREAS, City Council authorized the submittal of a grant application to the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and acceptance of the grant offer for up to \$6,060,000.00 for the Residential Acoustical Treatment Program (RATP) which is managed by THC, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance will authorize the City Manager or her designee to amend the Professional Services Agreement with THC, Inc. in the increased amount not to exceed of \$6,060,000.00 upon receipt and execution of the new FAA grant offer for the RATP to be awarded in 2017; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee, or the Aviation Director, is hereby authorized to execute an amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with THC, Inc. for the management of the Residential Acoustical Treatment program, increasing the contract value by an amount up to \$6,060,000.00 subject to the receipt and execution of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) grant offer for the Residential Acoustical Treatment Program (RATP) grant to be awarded in 2017.

SECTION 2. Payment in the amount not to exceed \$6,060,000.00 is authorized to be encumbered in SAP Fund 51099000, Airport Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 33-00170, Residential Acoustical Treatment Program and made payable to THC, Inc. for the design, construction, public relations, and legal components of the Residential Acoustical Treatment Program.

SECTION 3. Payments for services are contingent upon the availability of funds and the award and acceptance of the RATP 2017 grant.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP

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Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
