

RESOLUTION NO.

RECOMMENDING THE EXTENSION OF THE CITY LIMITS BY THE FULL PURPOSE ANNEXATION OF ANNEXATION AREAS (A) IH 10 WEST COMMERCIAL CORRIDOR, (B) BABCOCK ROAD CORRIDOR, (C) CULEBRA ROAD – ALAMO RANCH CORRIDOR, (D) WISEMAN BOULEVARD CORRIDOR, (E) POTRANCO ROAD–WEST LOOP 1604 COMMERCIAL CORRIDORS, (F) VANCE JACKSON–NORTH LOOP 1604 WEST TRACTS, (G) FOSTER ROAD AREA, AND (H) IH 10 EAST–LOOP 1604 EAST INTERCHANGE AREA TOTALING APPROXIMATELY 19.96 SQUARE MILES OF LAND CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO LIMITS AND WITHIN THE SAN ANTONIO EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION IN BEXAR COUNTY, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 43 OF THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE.

WHEREAS, the proposed annexation is with consistent the City of San Antonio Annexation Policy by which San Antonio considers annexation necessary for the City’s protection of environmental, cultural, historical, economic, and other resources; and

WHEREAS, the annexation area located contiguous to the City limits of San Antonio, within San Antonio’s Extraterritorial Jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the proposed annexation areas are exempt from inclusion into a Municipal Annexation Plan because each respectively contains fewer than 100 separate tracts of land on which one or more residential dwellings are located; and

WHEREAS, Section 123A of the Charter of the City of San Antonio requires that the Planning Commission shall make a recommendation to City Council on proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Planning Commission held a public hearing on August 9, 2017; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1: The San Antonio Planning Commission recommends the approval of the full purpose annexation of Annexation Areas A through H, generally described in the map in Exhibit “A” consisting of approximately 19.96 square miles, contiguous to the City of San Antonio limits and within the City of San Antonio’s Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (ETJ) in Bexar County, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 43 of the Texas Local Government Code.
