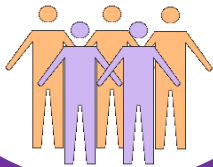

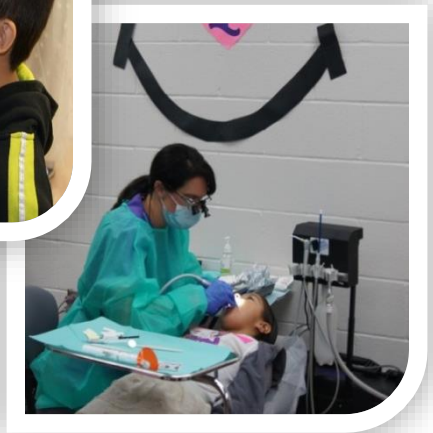

- Required by the Texas Law

Fiscal Impact

- Funding in an amount up to \$120,000.00 will be provided through three funding sources:
 - 1115 Medicaid Waiver: \$80,000.00
 - DSHS Title V Health and Dental Grant: \$30,000.00
 - General Fund: \$10,000.00
- Term: October 1, 2017 to September 30, 2018
