## FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING between the CITY OF SAN ANTONIO and BEXAR COUNTY (the SEP-HCP Permittees) and TEXAS PARKS AND WILDLIFE DEPARTMENT

## **ARTICLE I. RECITALS**

WHEREAS, this First Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and entered into by and between the City of San Antonio and Bexar County (the SEP-HCP Permittees) and Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD), hereinafter collectively referred to as the Parties; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into the MOU by instrument dated effective May 19, 2017, which, under Article VI. B., states that the Parties may amend the MOU, and said amendment shall become effective upon the approval of the Parties in writing; and

WHEREAS, the Parties are engaged in discussions related to a long term agreement to supersede the MOU, and desire to extend the time frame for said discussions; and

WHEREAS, the Parties now wish to amend the MOU as described in Article II. below.

## **ARTICLE II. AMENDMENT**

1. The MOU by and between the Parties is hereby amended to extend the term of the MOU until December 31, 2017.

2. All references to the ending date of the MOU as being "September 30, 2017", are hereby amended and replaced to reflect an ending date of "December 31, 2017".

## **ARTICLE III. SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

Except as expressly modified by this First Amendment, the terms and conditions of the MOU remain in full force and effect.
