## AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING AN**AGREEMENT** WITH COMMUNITIES IN SCHOOLS OF SAN ANTONIO FOR ADOLESCENT HEALTH SERVICES TO PROVIDE IN-SCHOOL BEHAVIORAL AND MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING **FOR** THE **SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN** HEALTH **DISTRICT'S TEEN** PREGNANCY PREVENTION MEDICAID 1115 WAIVER PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$216,000.00 FOR A **OCTOBER 1, 2017** COMMENCING SEPTEMBER 30, 2018, AND FURTHER PROVIDES TWO, ONE-YEAR RENEWAL OPTIONS.

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2013, City Council authorized the submission of six project proposals by San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) through the Regional Healthcare Partnership Anchor entity, University Health System for consideration and funding in the amount of \$43,392,942.00 through the new Delivery System Reform Incentive Payment (DSRIP) arm of the "Texas Healthcare Transformation and Quality Improvement Program" or "Transformation Waiver"; and

WHEREAS, Metro Health carefully selected projects in the following areas: diabetes prevention, children's oral health services, HIV and Syphilis prevention, breastfeeding promotion, teen pregnancy prevention and neighborhood health promotion; and

WHEREAS, all six project proposals are in alignment with Metro Health's strategic plan and many community goals set forth by SA2020 and have the overall goal of improving health outcomes; and

WHEREAS, the initial demonstration period came to an end on September 30, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, with a 15 month extension period approved by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services set to expire December 31, 2017, HHSC has requested an additional 21 month renewal of the program that if approved, would extend the term of the 1115 Waiver through September 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, authorization of this agreement will allow Metro Health to provide funding to Communities in School of San Antonio for the implementation of an adolescent health services project for the prevention of teen pregnancy in San Antonio; and

**WHEREAS**, this agreement is subject to and contingent upon continued Medicaid 1115 Waiver funding; **NOW THEREFORE**:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or her designee is authorized to execute an agreement with Communities in Schools of San Antonio (CISSA) for adolescent health services to provide in-school behavioral and mental health counseling for the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District's Teen Pregnancy Prevention Medicaid 1115 Waiver Program in an amount up to \$216,000.00 for a term commencing October 1, 2017 to September 30, 2018, and further provides two, one-year renewal options. A copy of the agreement in substantially final form is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I.** 

## SECTION 2. [FINANCIAL LANGUAGE PENDING]

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
