## AN ORDINANCE 2017 - 09 - 21 - 0710

AUTHORIZING THE SECOND AND FINAL ONE YEAR RENEWAL OF TWO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENTS FOR STANDBY LANDFILL COMPLIANCE, ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION AND CONSULTING SERVICES WITH TTL, INC. (FORMERLY KNOWN AS DRASH CONSULTANTS, LLC), AND STEARNS, CONRAD, AND SCHMIDT, CONSULTING ENGINEERS, INC., DBA SCS ENGINEERS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$165,000.00 FOR EACH FIRM DURING THE TERM OF THE RENEWAL, FOR VARIOUS CLOSED CITY LANDFILLS AND OTHER ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE PROJECTS CITY WIDE, FUNDED BY THE SOLID WASTE OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE FUND AND THROUGH ALLOCATIONS FROM SPECIFIC PROJECT FUNDS AT THE TIME WORK IS REQUIRED

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WHEREAS, due to the highly regulated nature of environmental activities, and the quantity of work, it is necessary to hire consultants for environmental assessment, testing, and reporting on various, as yet to be named, projects for landfill and environmental compliance to be used on an as needed basis; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2015-10-01-0847 authorized the execution of two professional service agreements with Drash Consultants, LLC, and Stearns, Conrad, and Schmidt, Consulting Engineers, Inc., dba SCS Engineers, to provide technical assistance to the Solid Waste Management Department for various landfill and environmental activities, including groundwater monitoring, landfill gas monitoring and repairs, leachate collection, permit modifications, and performing site assessments, with a contract term for one year, through September 30, 2016, with two additional optional one year terms; Ordinance 2016-09-15-0707 authorized the first one year renewal option, which expires on September 30, 2017; in 2016 Drash Consultants, LLC merged with TTL, Inc. and the agreement was transferred to TTL, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance authorizes the second and final one year renewal of two professional services agreements with TTL, Inc., and Stearns, Conrad, and Schmidt, Consulting Engineers, Inc., dba SCS Engineers, under identical terms and conditions, for standby landfill compliance, environmental remediation and consulting services, in an amount not to exceed \$165,000.00 for each firm during the term of the renewal, funded by the Solid Waste Operating and Maintenance Fund and through allocations from specific project funds at the time the work is required; NOW THEREFORE,

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The professional services contracts with TTL, INC. (fka Drash Consultants, LLC), and STEARNS, CONRAD, AND SCHMIDT, CONSULTING ENGINEERS, INC., dba SCS ENGINEERS, are hereby renewed for the second and final one-year renewal period,

starting October 1, 2017 and ending September 30, 2018, under identical terms and conditions, for standby landfill compliance, environmental remediation and consulting services, in an amount not to exceed \$165,000.00 for each firm during the term of the renewal, funded by the Solid Waste Operating and Maintenance Fund and through allocations from specific project funds at the time the work is required.

**SECTION 2.** The amount up to \$165,000.00 will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to **TTL, INC.** (fka Drash Consultants, LLC). All expenditures are contingent upon the availability of funds from the City's operating budget and City Council approval for FY2018.

**SECTION 3.** The amount up to \$165,000.00 will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to **STEARNS, CONRAD, AND SCHMIDT CONSULTING ENGINEERS, INC.**, dba **SCS ENGINEERS**. All expenditures are contingent upon the availability of funds from the City's operating budget and City Council approval for FY2018.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.
