ACCEPTING THE BIDS FROM CLARKE MOSQUITO CONTROL PRODUCTS, INC. AND TARGET SPECIALTY PRODUCTS TO PROVIDE PESTICIDE PRODUCTS FOR THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT FOR AN ESTIMATED TOTAL COST OF \$80,000.00.

WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio with pesticide products for use by licensed personnel of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District to control various mosquito borne diseases; and

WHEREAS, Target Specialty Products (Items 1, 3-7 and 9) and Clarke Mosquito Control Products, Inc. (Item 10) submitted the lowest bids for an estimated total cost of \$16,000.00 annually; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The low bids from Target Specialty Products (Items 1, 3-7 and 9) and Clarke Mosquito Control Products, Inc. (Item 10) to provide pesticide products for the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District for an estimated total cost of \$16,000.00 annually is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation sheet and bids are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders and payment is authorized to the vendors identified herein. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2018 budget and such other appropriations necessary to fund the contracts through their terms as evidenced by subsequent ordinances.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
