WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by Consolidated Traffic Controls, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Transportation and Capital Improvements Department with a School Zone Flasher Communication System for an estimated annual cost of \$317,000.00, using the Houston-Galveston Area Council contract number PE05-17; and

WHEREAS, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the Houston/Galveston Area Council of Governments Cooperative Purchasing Agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio on October 10, 1996 through Resolution No. 96-41-48; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The offer from Consolidated Traffic Controls, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Transportation and Capital Improvements Department with a School Zone Flasher Communication System for an estimated annual cost of \$317,000.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the bid tabulation sheet and contract are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit A**.

SECTION 2. The amount up to \$ \$317,000.00 will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to Consolidated Traffic Controls, Inc. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2018 budget and subsequent budgets that fall within the term period of this contract approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
