AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING A PROPOSAL FO A JOB ORDER CONTRACT WITH THE BRANDT COMPANIES, LLC FOR THE PURCHASE OF EIGHT HVAC UNITS FOR THE TERMINAL A RENOVATIONS PHASE III PROJECT IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$667,124.00 FOR THE SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

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WHEREAS, Ordinance No. ______ authorized a Job Order Contract (JOC) with The Brandt Companies, LLC for rapid and reliable HVAC services at the various facilities located within the San Antonio Airport System to augment existing Aviation staff on an "as-needed" basis, and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to remove and replace eight existing air units which have exceeded their life cycle and require replacement, and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance authorizes a Task Order to the JOC The Brandt Companies, LLC in the total amount of \$667,124.00 for removal of the eight air units and installation of their replacements and associated equipment at the San Antonio International Airport ; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee is authorized to issue a Task Order to the Job Order Contract with The Brandt Companies, LLC for removal of eight air units and installation of their replacements and associated equipment at the San Antonio International Airport in the total amount of \$667,124.00.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
