

- In San Antonio:
 - ~ 100 mobile living parks
 - ~ 7,000 lots



Overview

- Recent cases in Mobiles Living Parks due to severe health and safety issues
 - Relocations of residents
 - Addressed reactively
- Post-mortem report identifies areas for improvement:
 - Proactive inspections



Current Process

- Mobile Living Parks are:
 - Required to register with the City's Metropolitan Health Department
 - Subject to inspections
 - Required to pay an annual fee of \$35
 - Paid by park owner for all lots
- Issue identified:
 - Property maintenance issues not always addressed by owners



Proposed Process

- Led by DSD and Metro Health
 - Increased involvement from DHS and CAO
- Review and streamline application process
- No fee changes



Proposed Process

- Monthly/quarterly proactive inspections
 - Multi-departmental
 - DSD, Metro Health, DHS
- Clarify:
 - Suspension
 - Revoke license for failure to comply
 - Appeals process
 - Additional violations and penalties
 - Civil and criminal
